







VISITORS AVERAGE % OF SPENDING BY TYPE 2017





Sarawak Economy By Sector 2016






Top 10 Country Visitor Arrivals 2017








COMPARISON ARRIVALS VIA AIRPORT YEAR 2016 & 2017




Comparison Arrivals via Land Year 2017

AVERAGE OCCUPANCY OF HOTELS 2017






