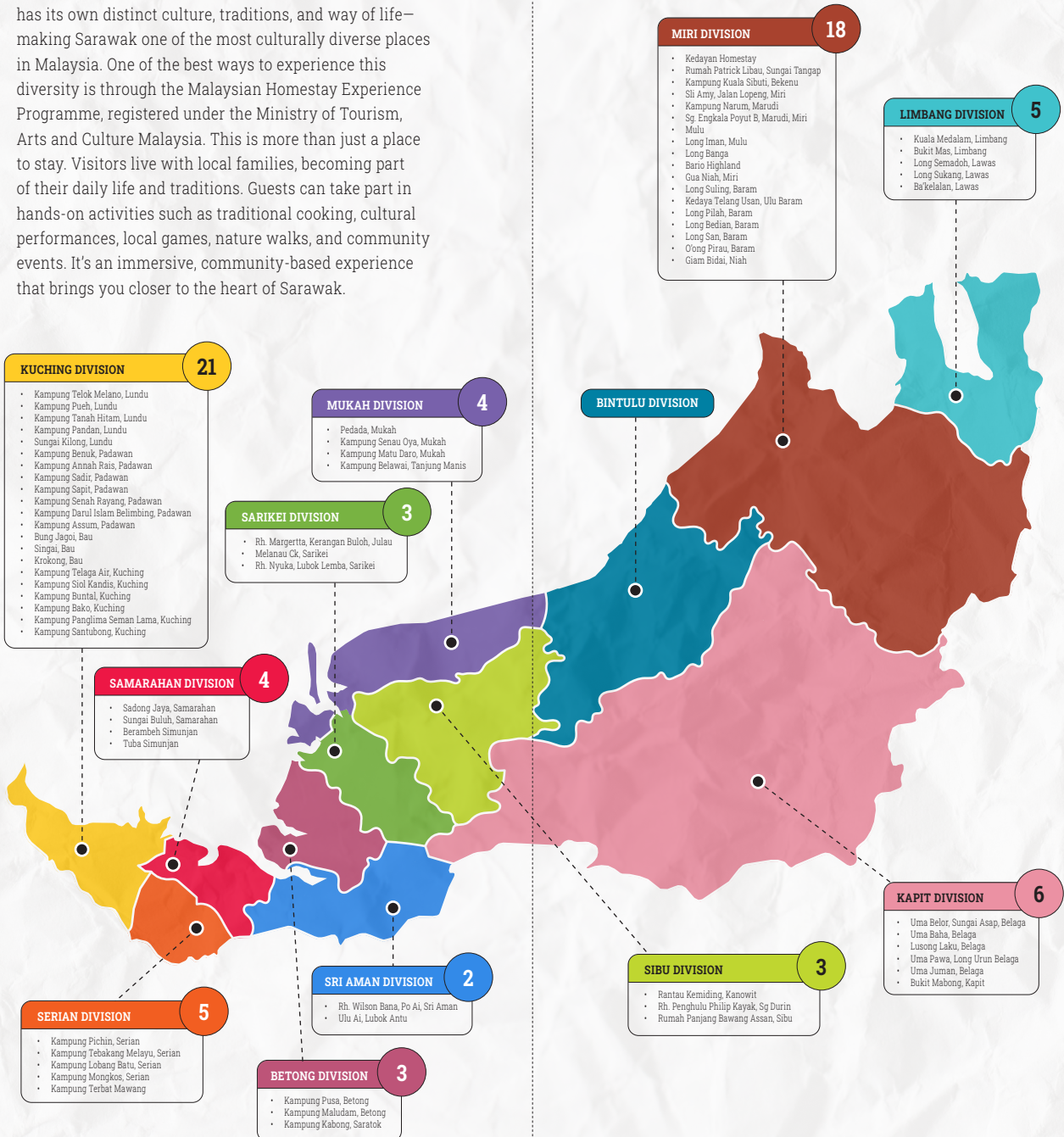

# REGISTERED HOMESTAY CLUSTERS IN SARAWAK

Sarawak, the Land of the Hornbills, is home to 34 ethnic groups who speak 45 different dialects. Each community has its own distinct culture, traditions, and way of life—making Sarawak one of the most culturally diverse places in Malaysia. One of the best ways to experience this diversity is through the Malaysian Homestay Experience Programme, registered under the Ministry of Tourism, Arts and Culture Malaysia. This is more than just a place to stay. Visitors live with local families, becoming part of their daily life and traditions. Guests can take part in hands-on activities such as traditional cooking, cultural performances, local games, nature walks, and community events. It's an immersive, community-based experience that brings you closer to the heart of Sarawak.

Today, there are 74 registered homestay clusters across Sarawak in the divisions and districts of Kuching, Samarahan, Serian, Sri Aman, Betong, Sarikei, Sibü, Mukah, Kapit, Miri, Limbang and Lawas, each representing different ethnic groups. Stay in a cosy homestay and discover the true spirit, warmth, and cultural richness of Sarawak.
