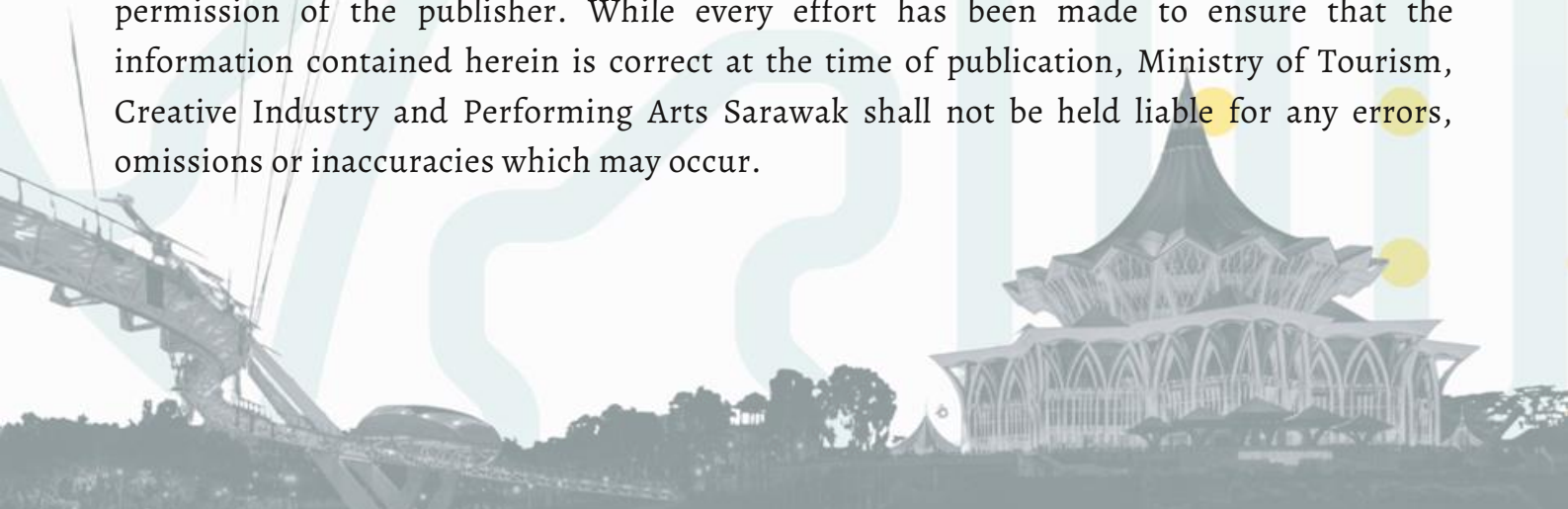

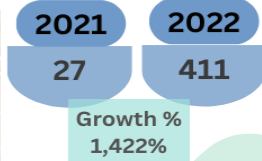

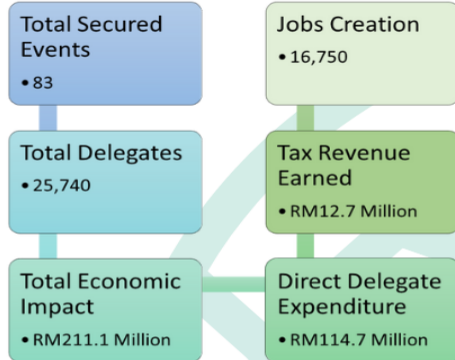
S-MM2H Top 3 Countries 2022



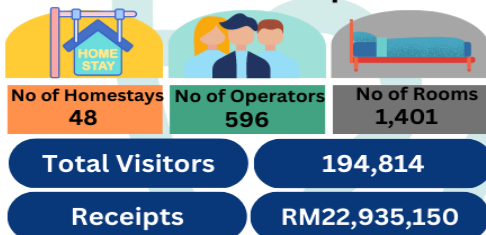

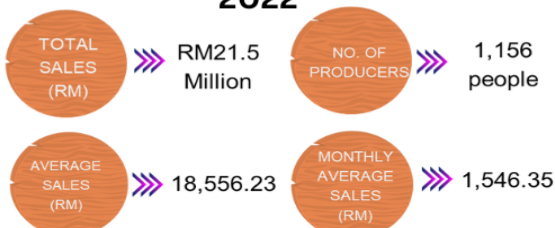

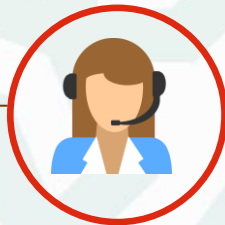

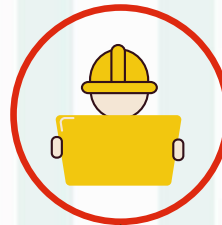

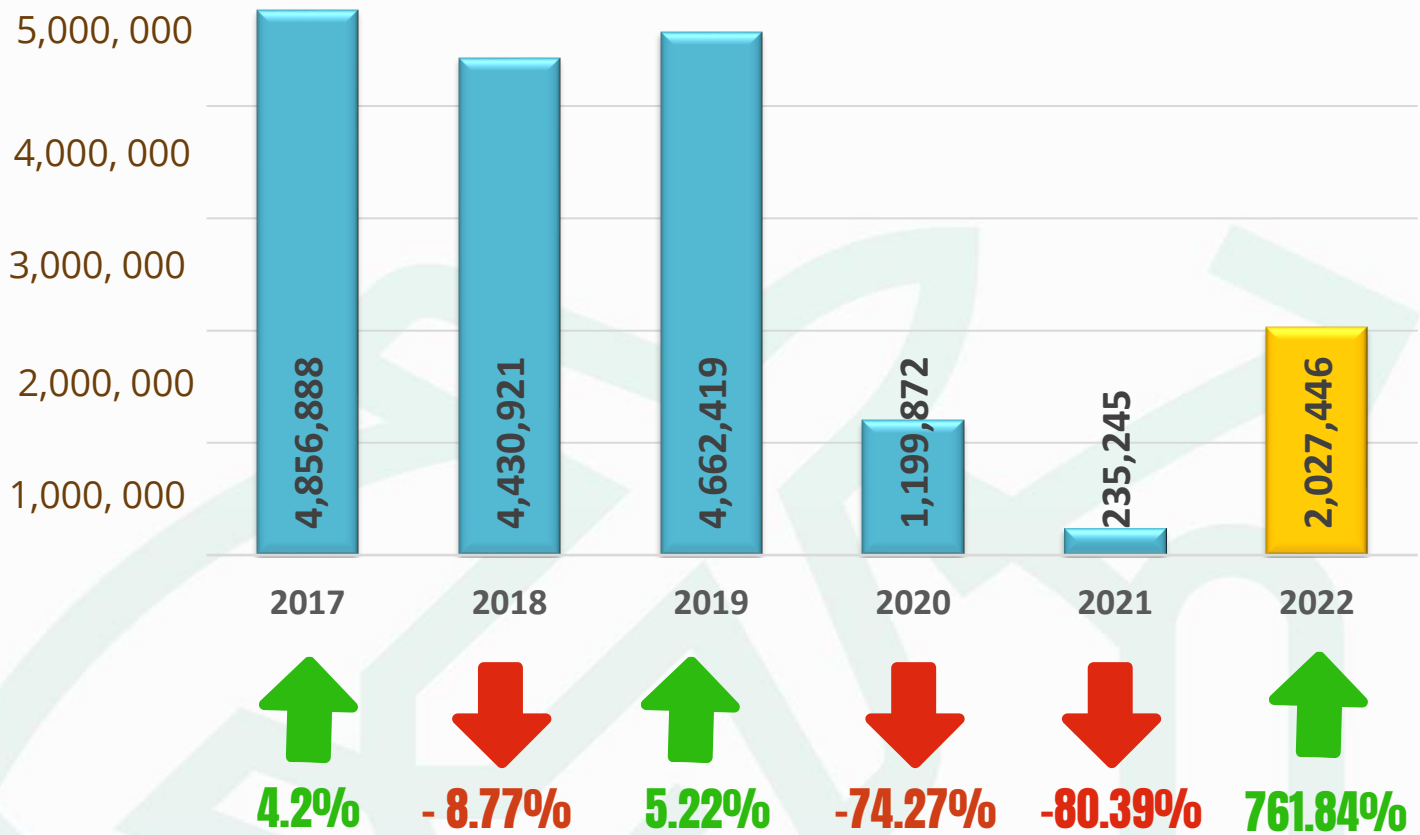

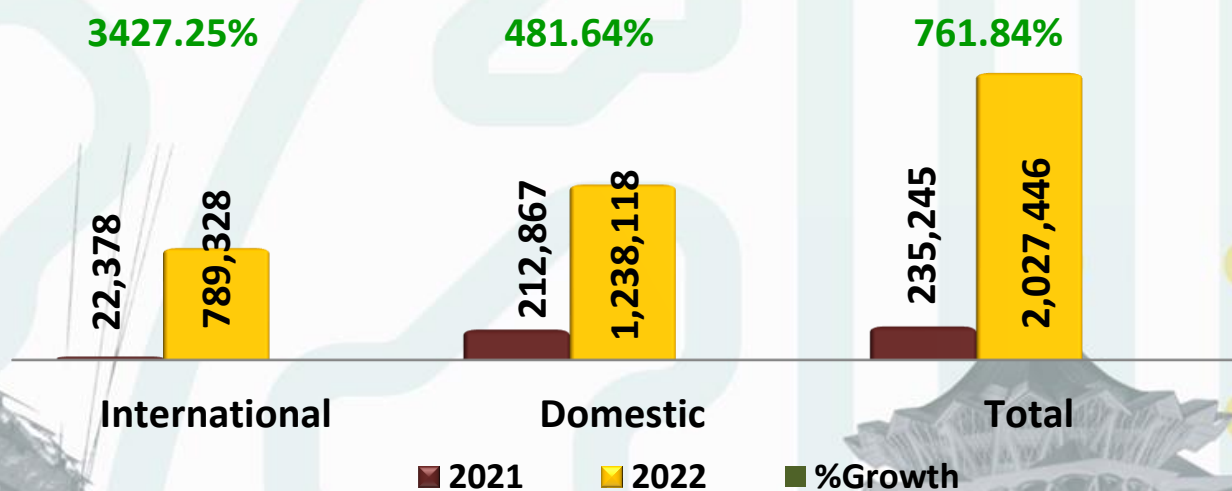

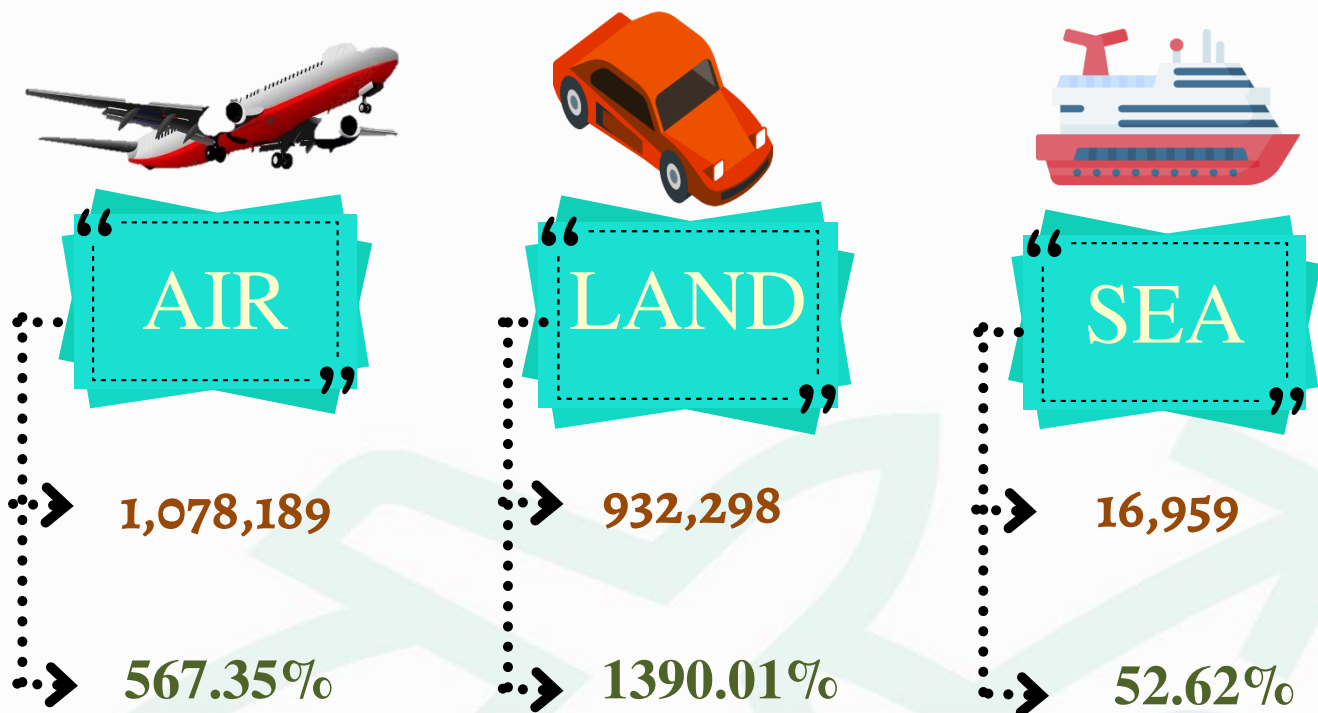

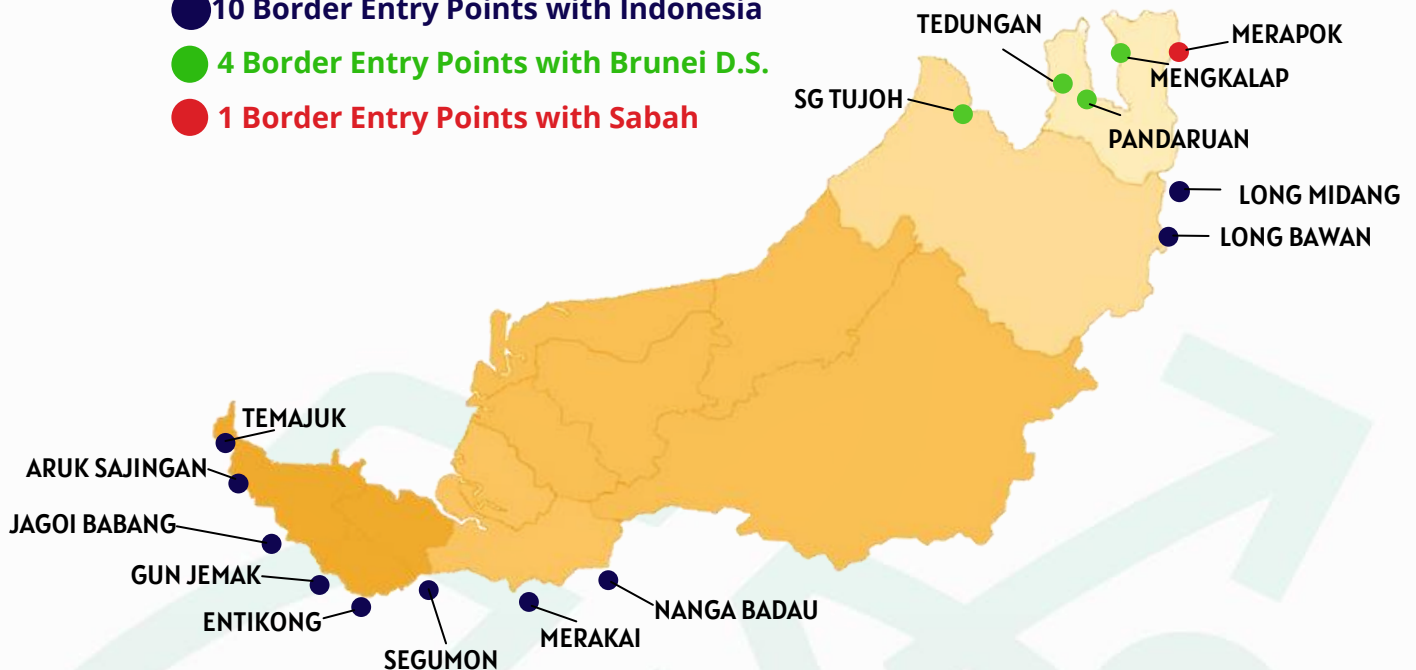

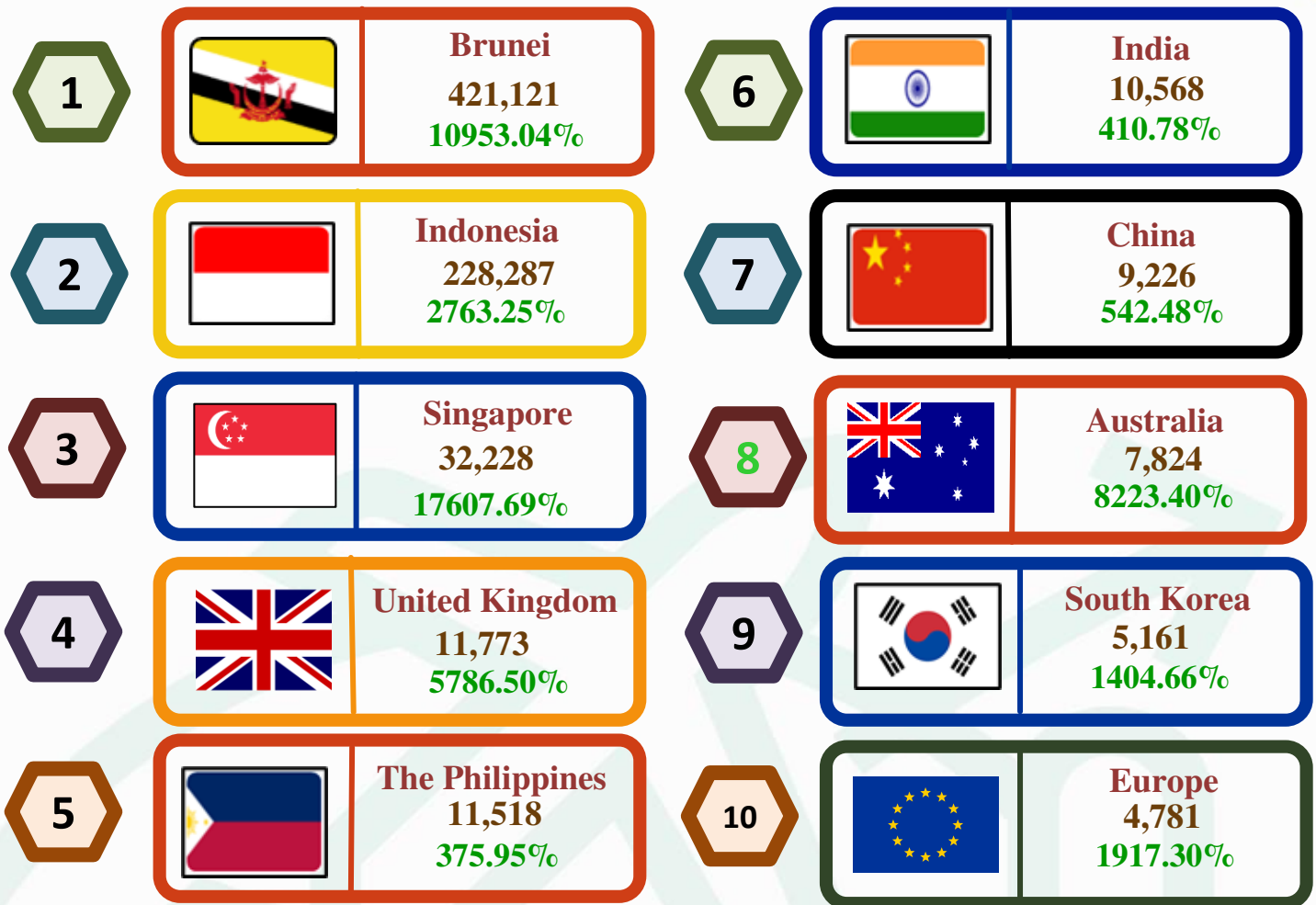

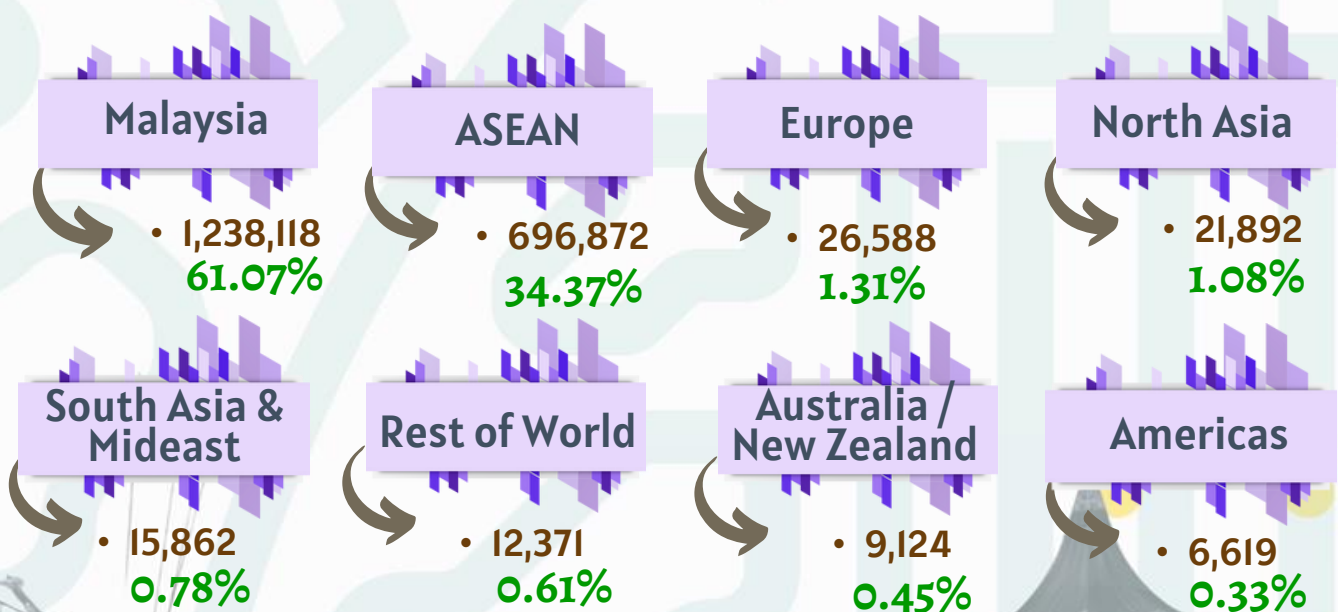

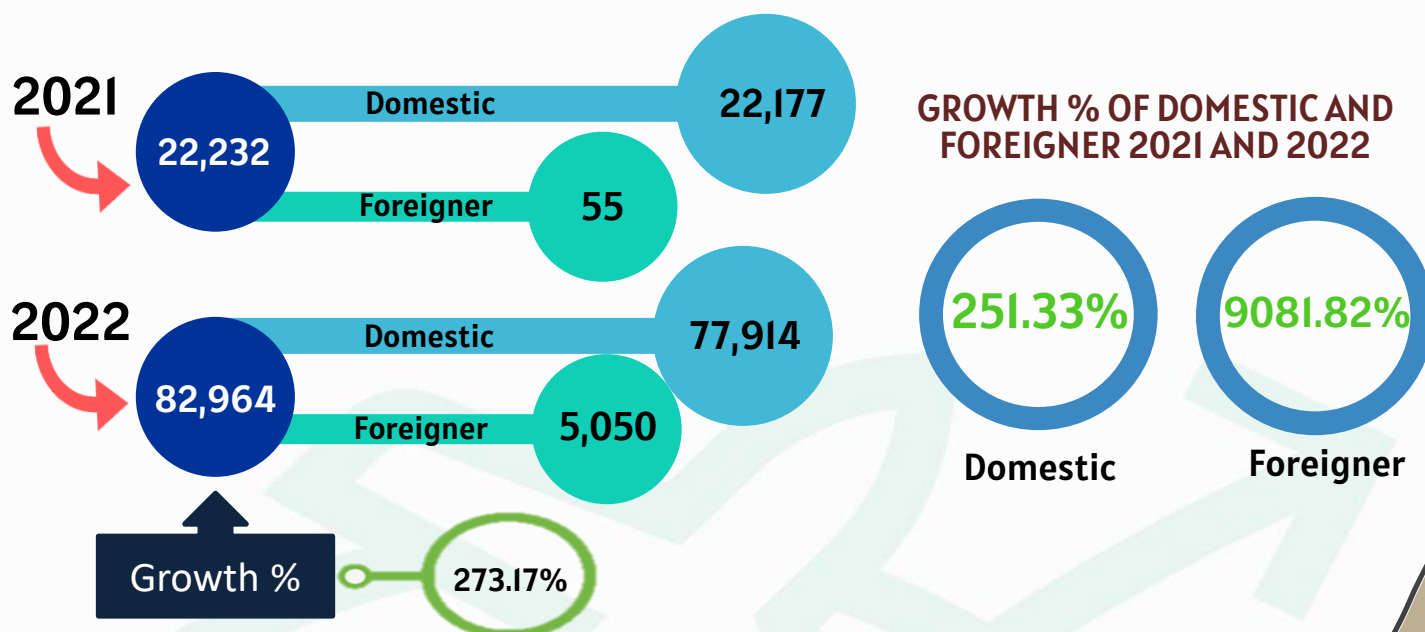


VISITOR ARRIVALS BY REGIONS 2022



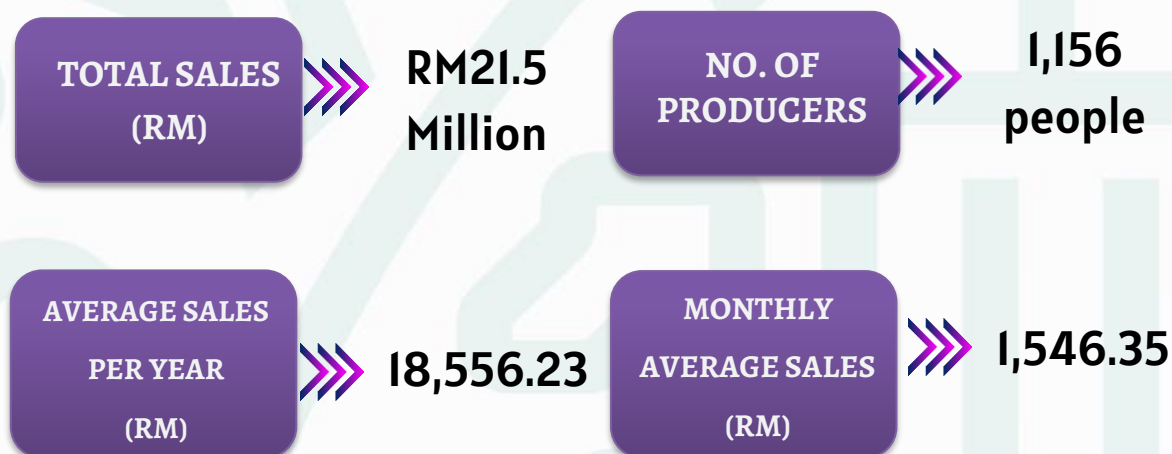

VISITOR ARRIVALS TO SARAWAK CULTURAL VILLAGE 2021 vs 2022



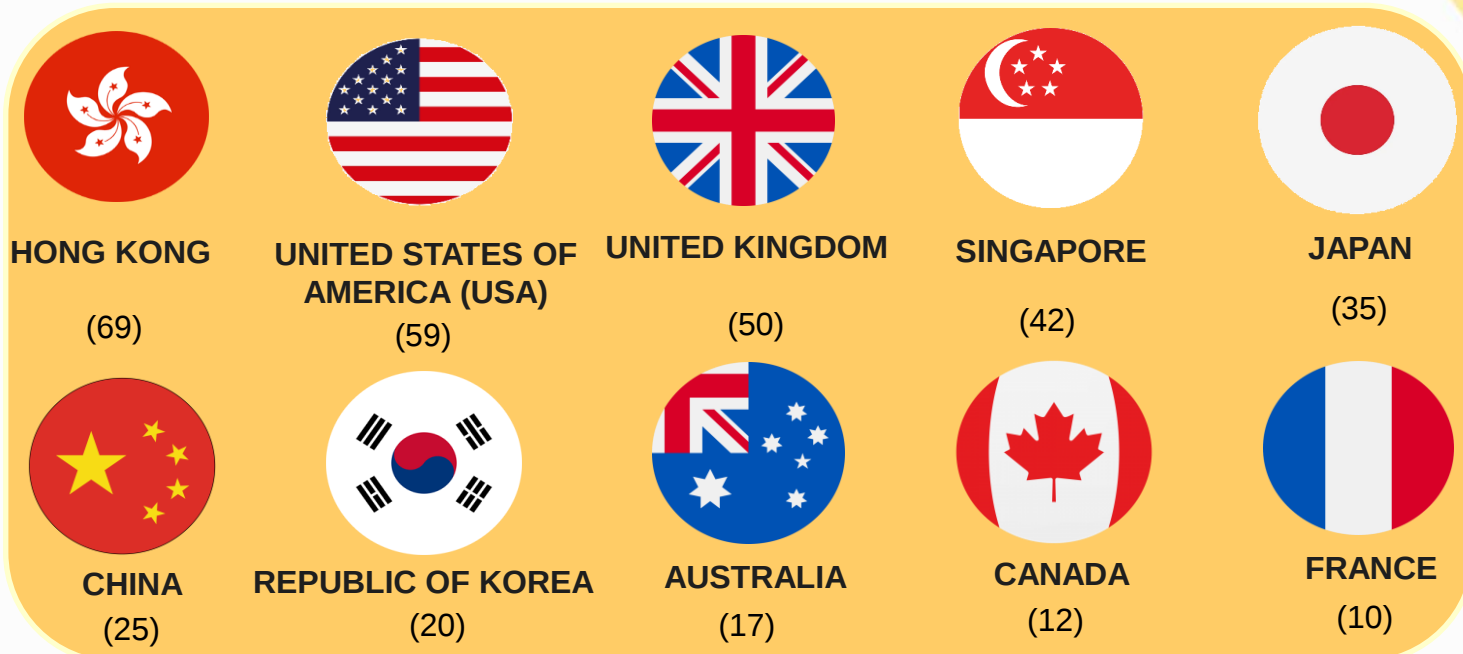

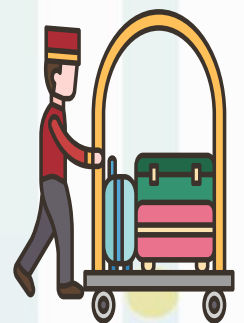

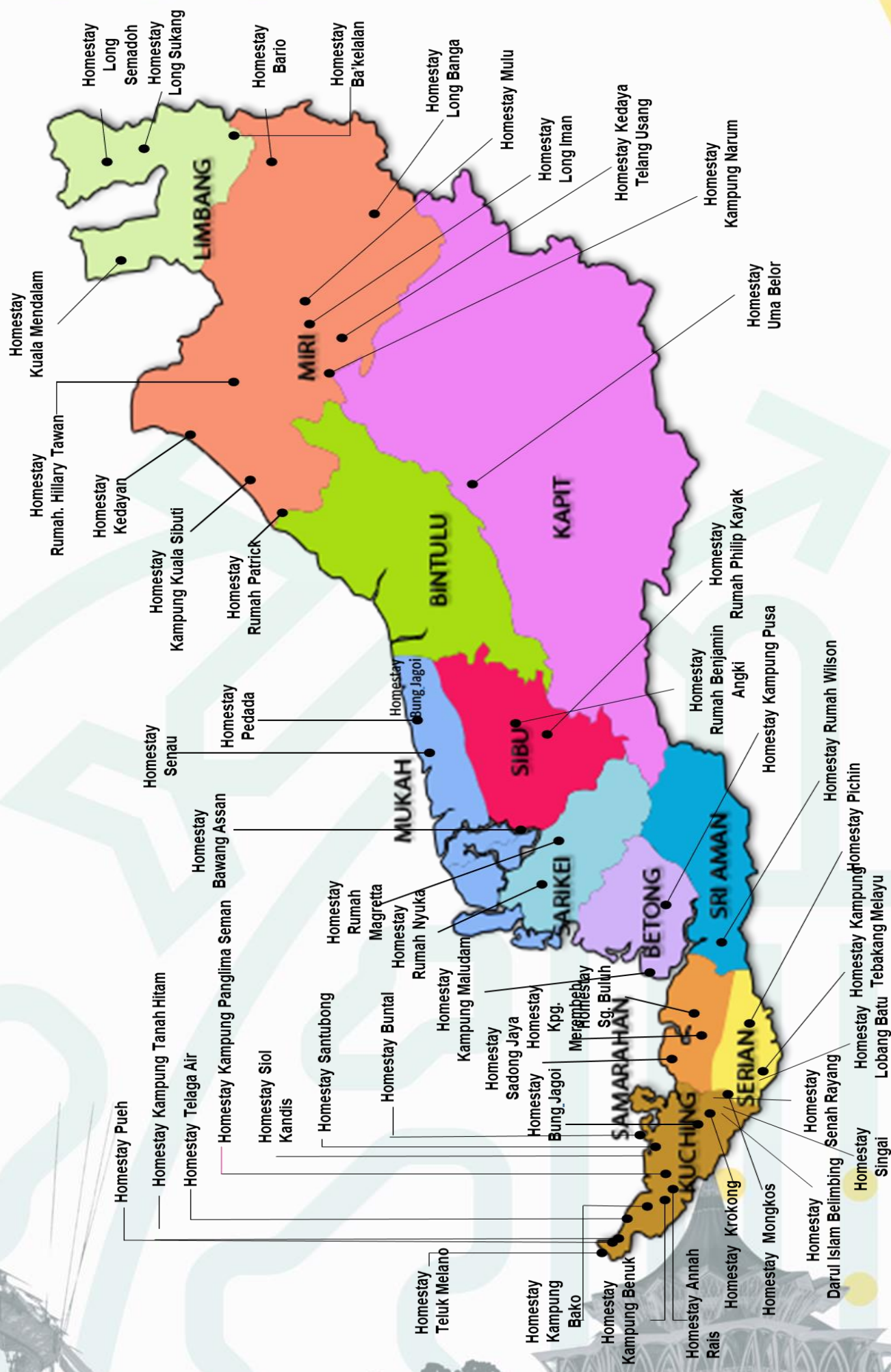

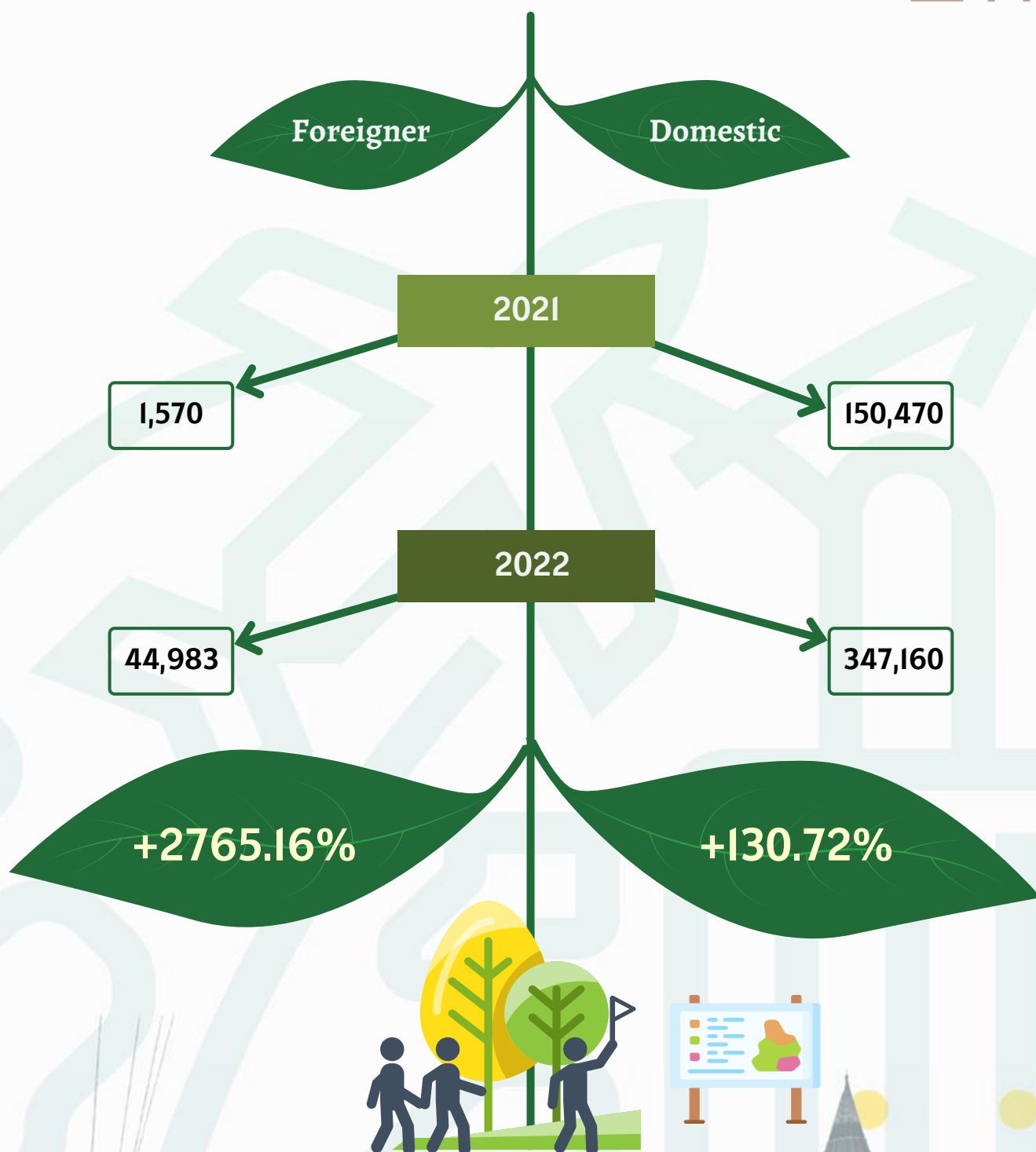
