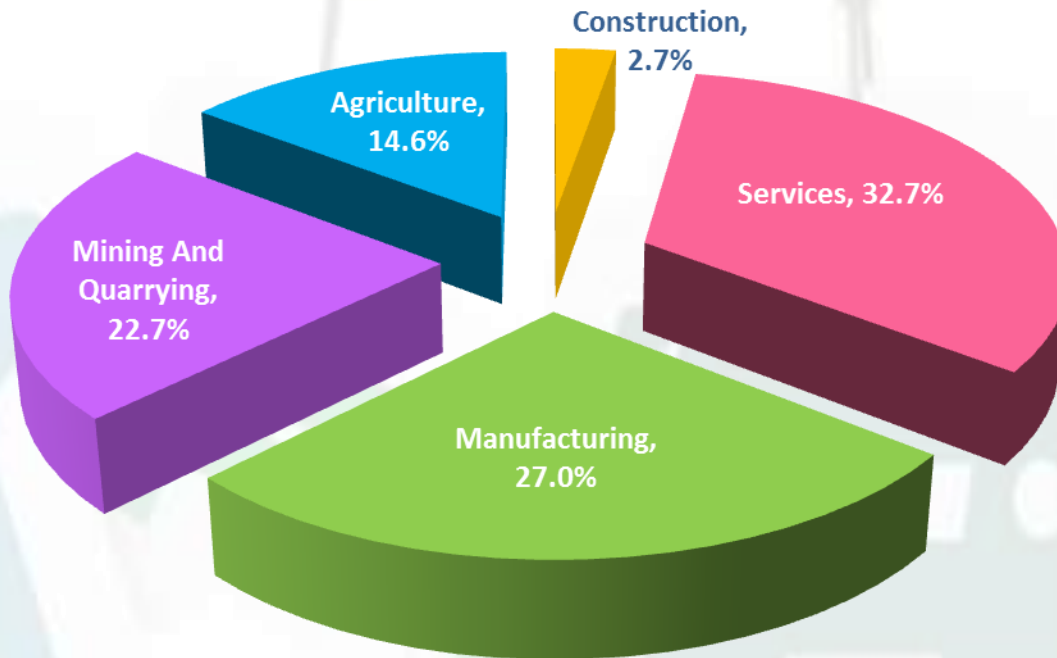

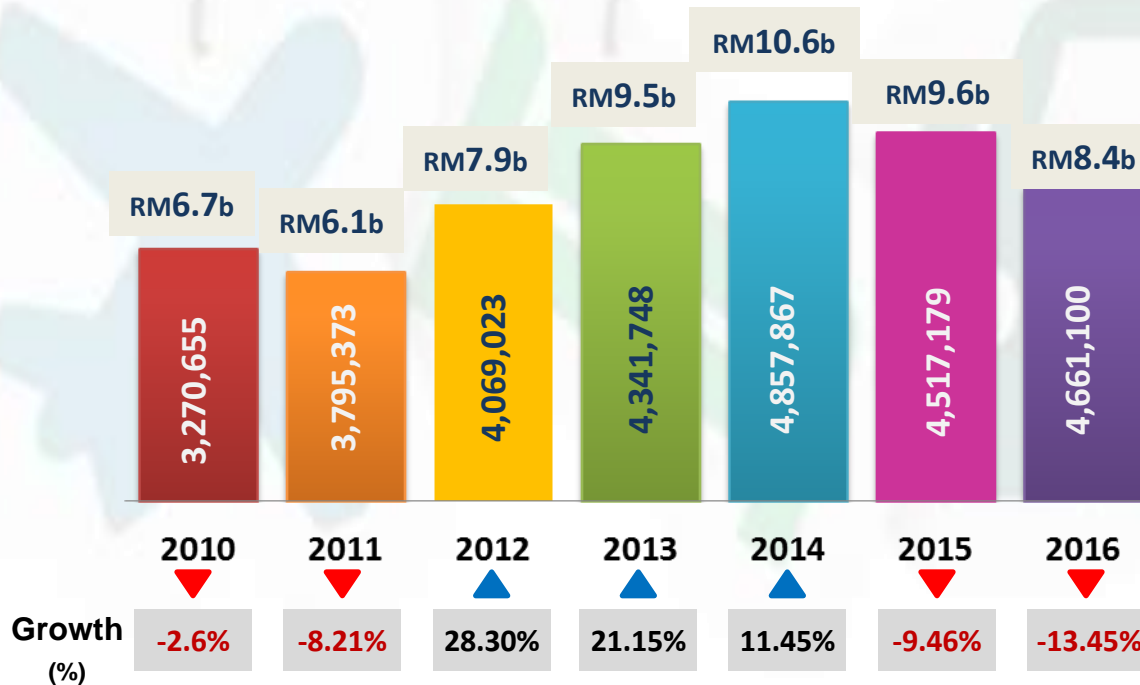

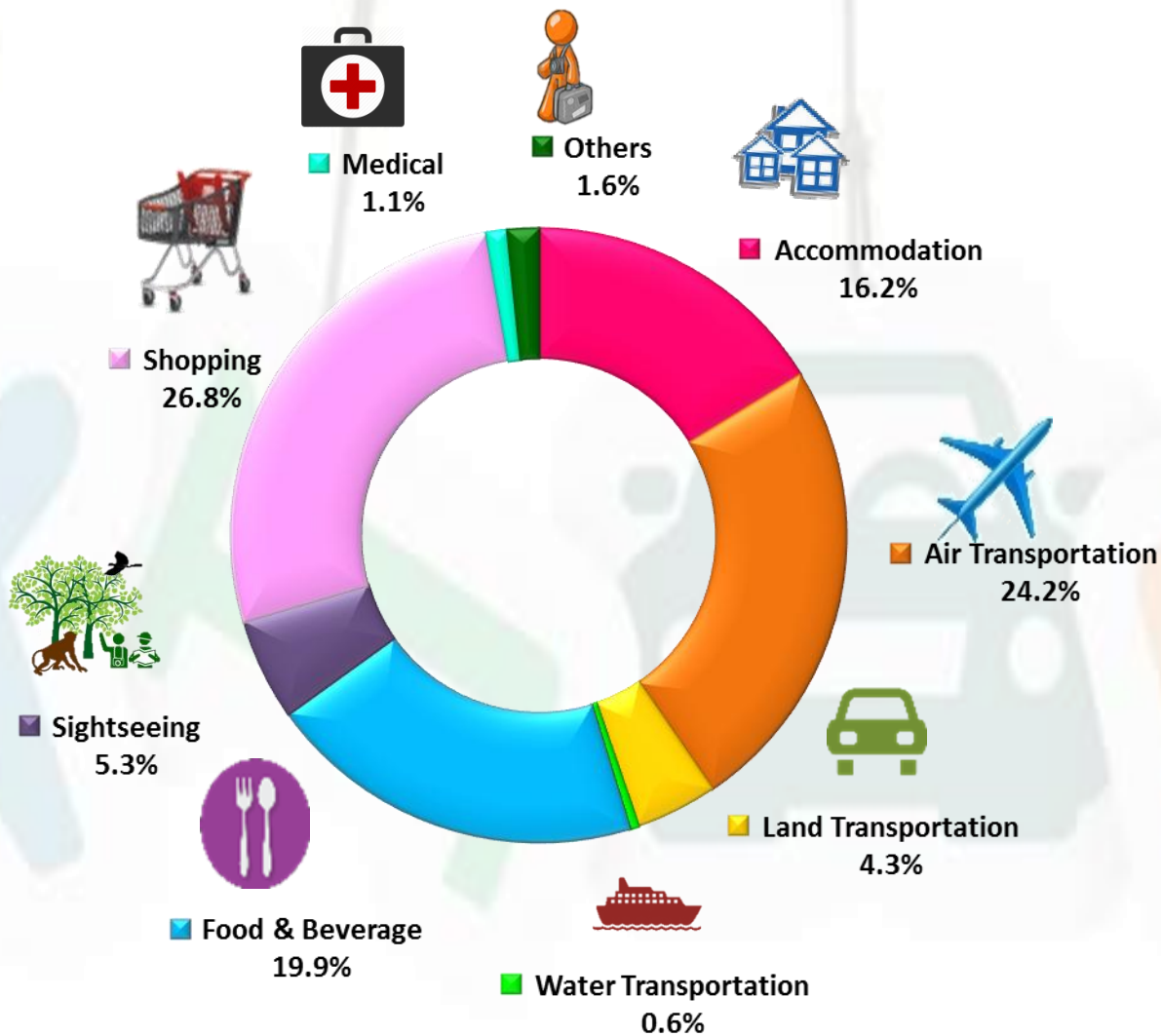

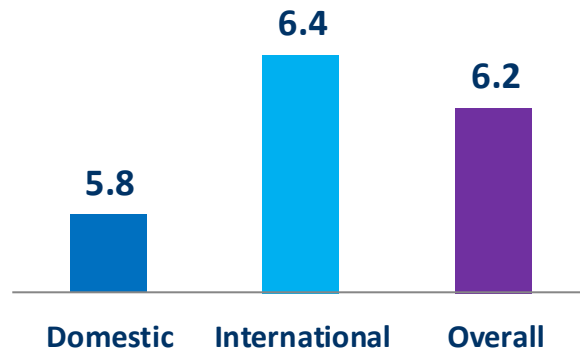

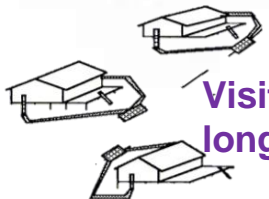

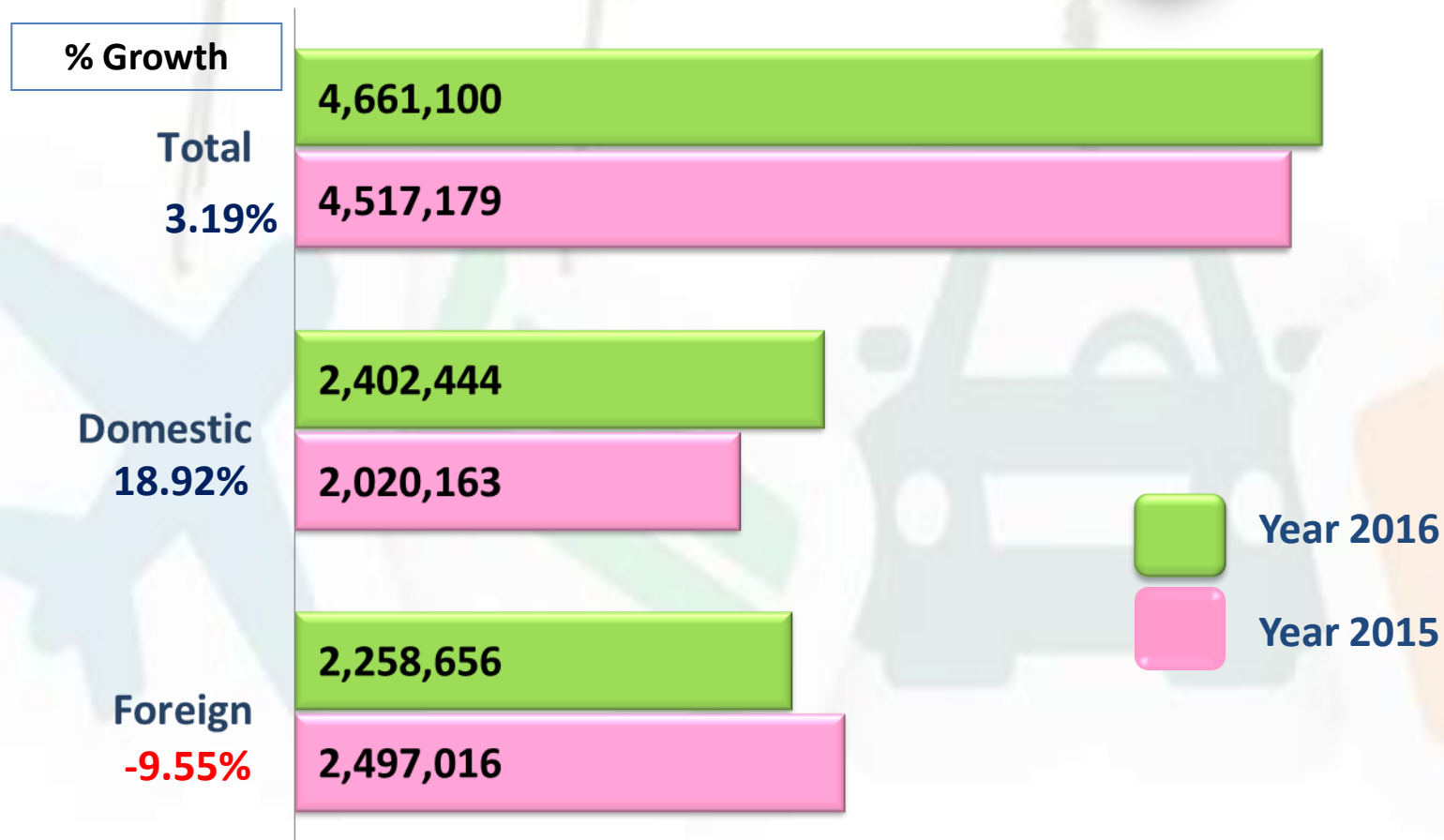

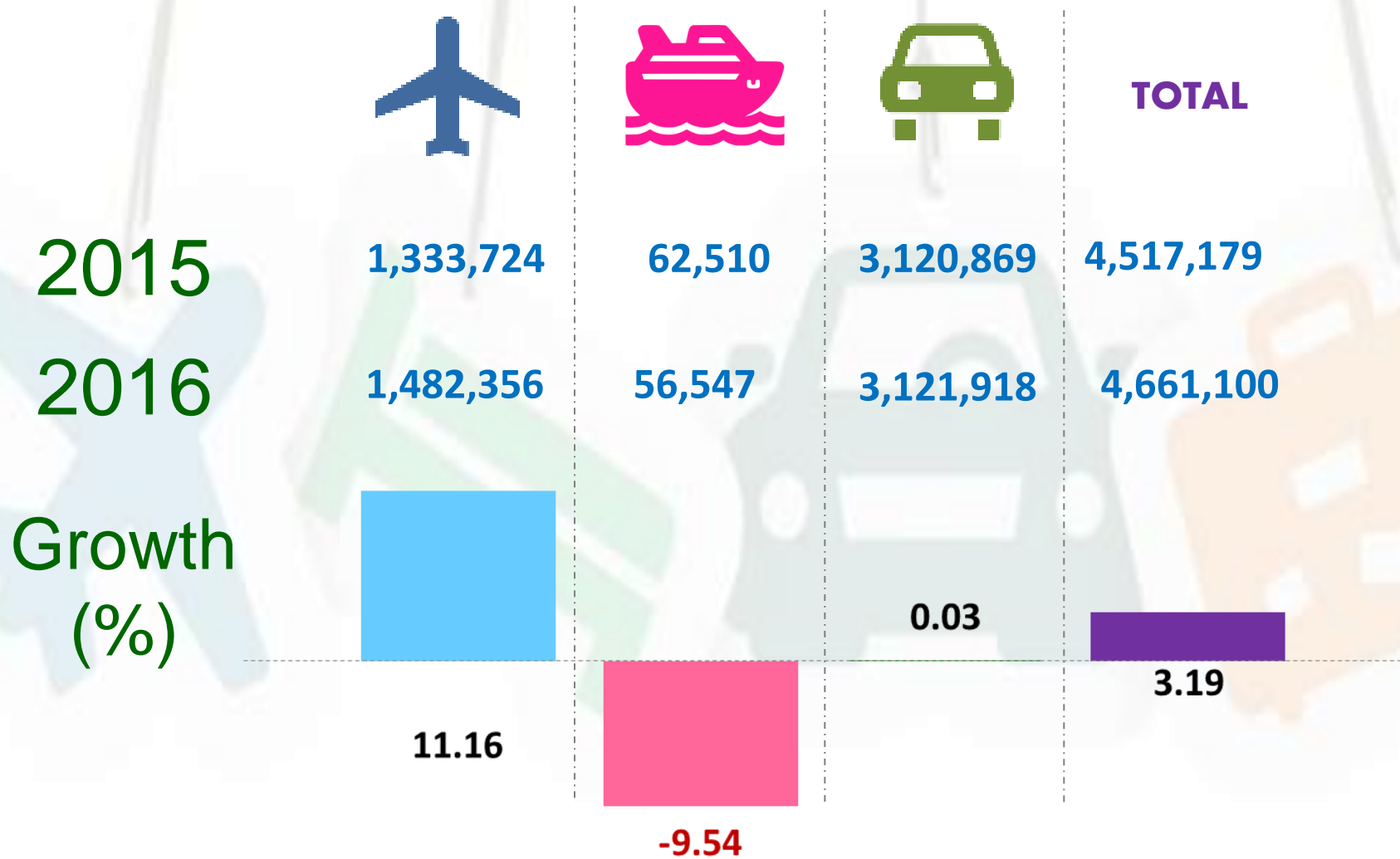

Comparison Arrivals by Mode of Transport into Sarawak Year 2015 & Year 2016

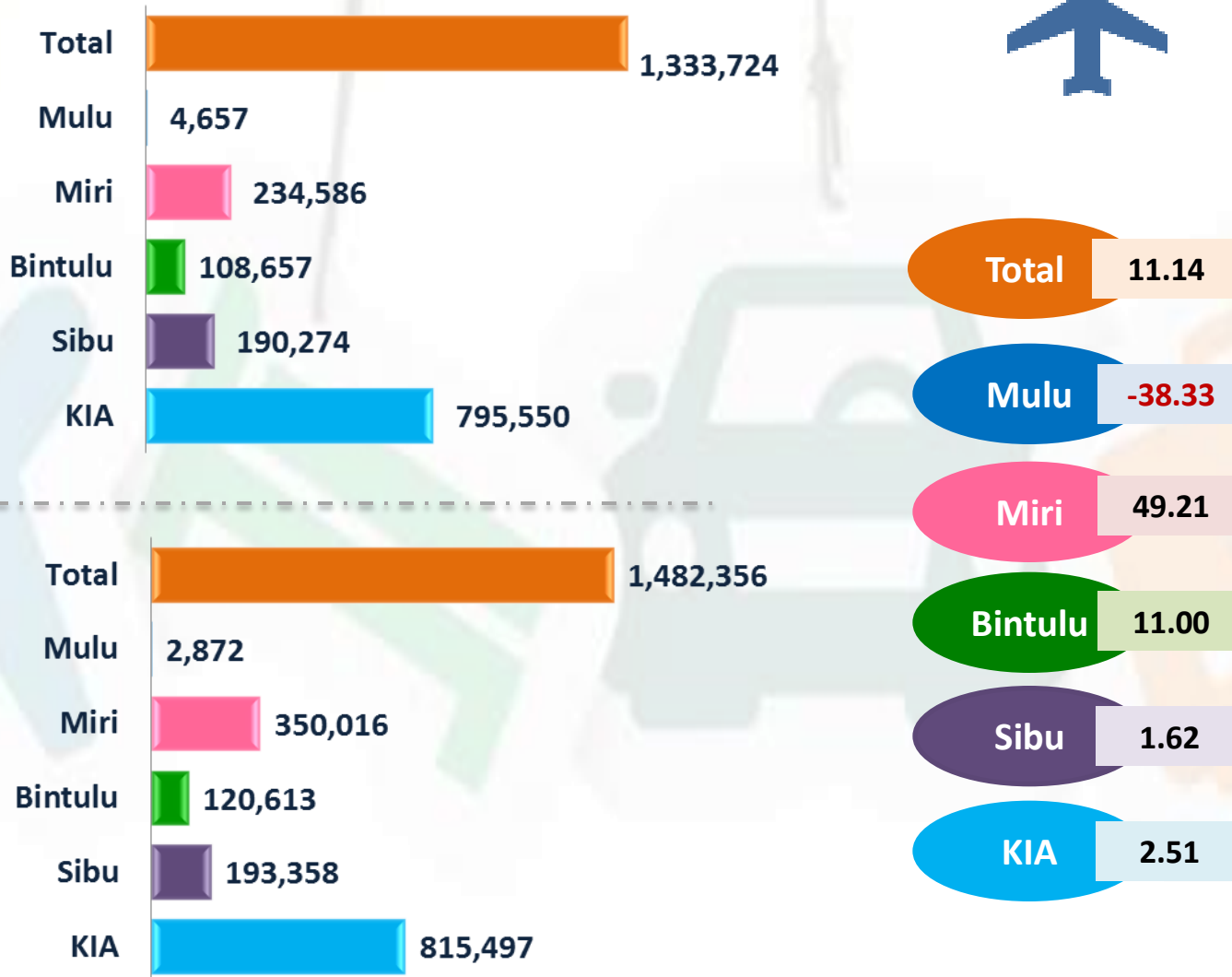

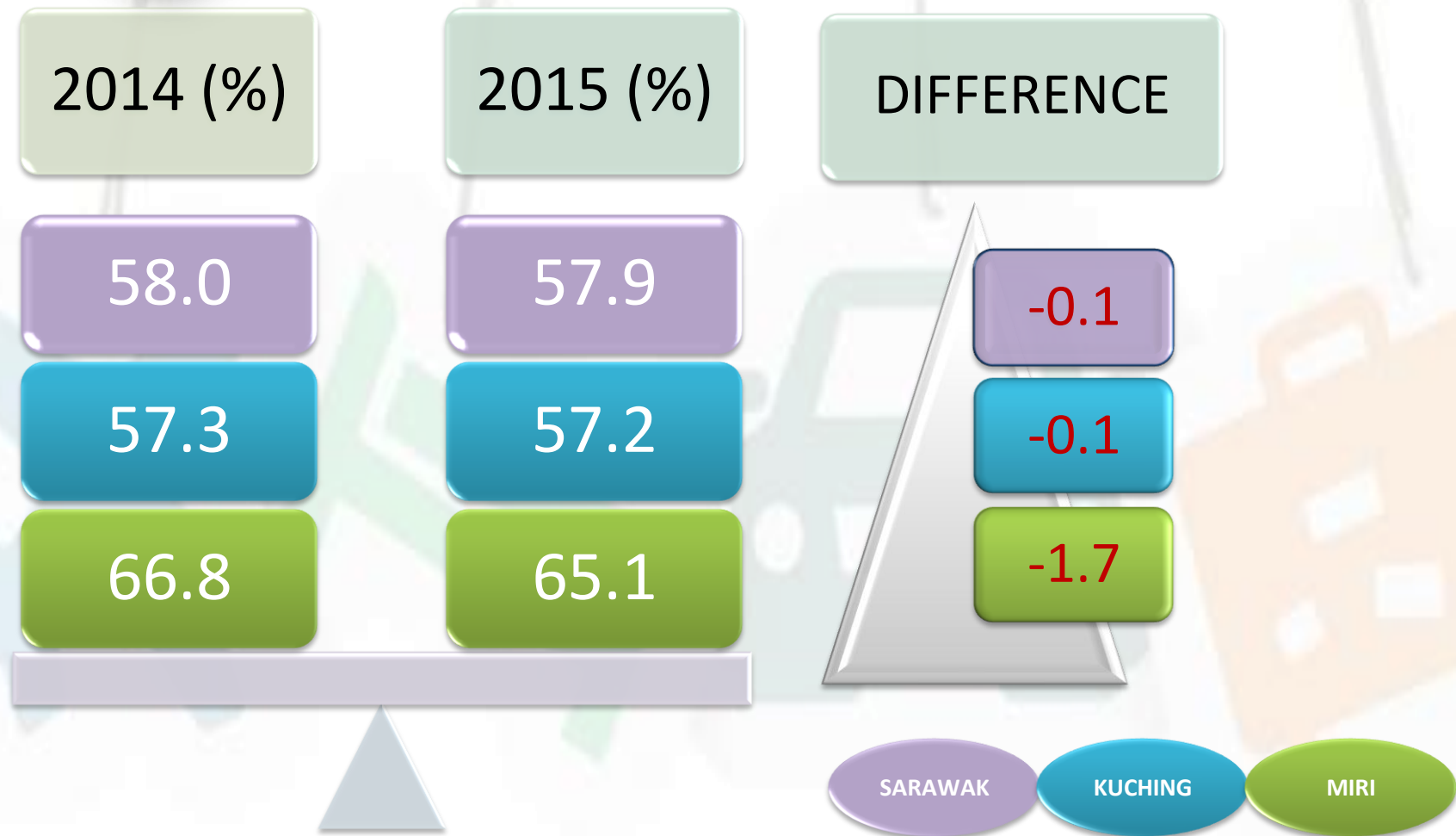

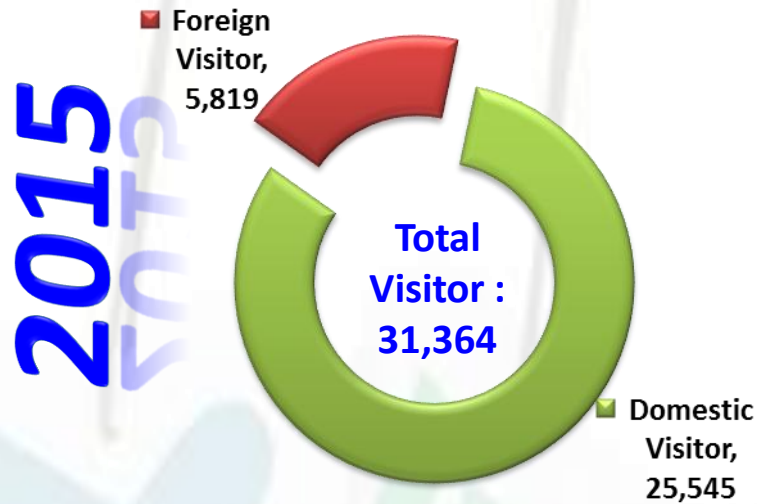

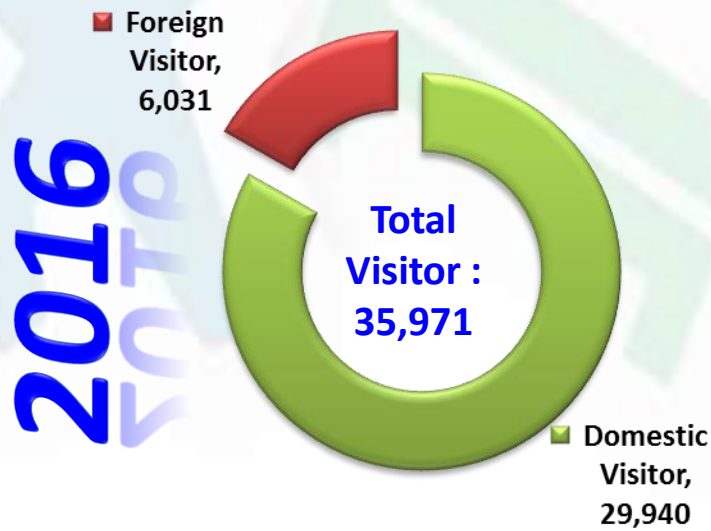

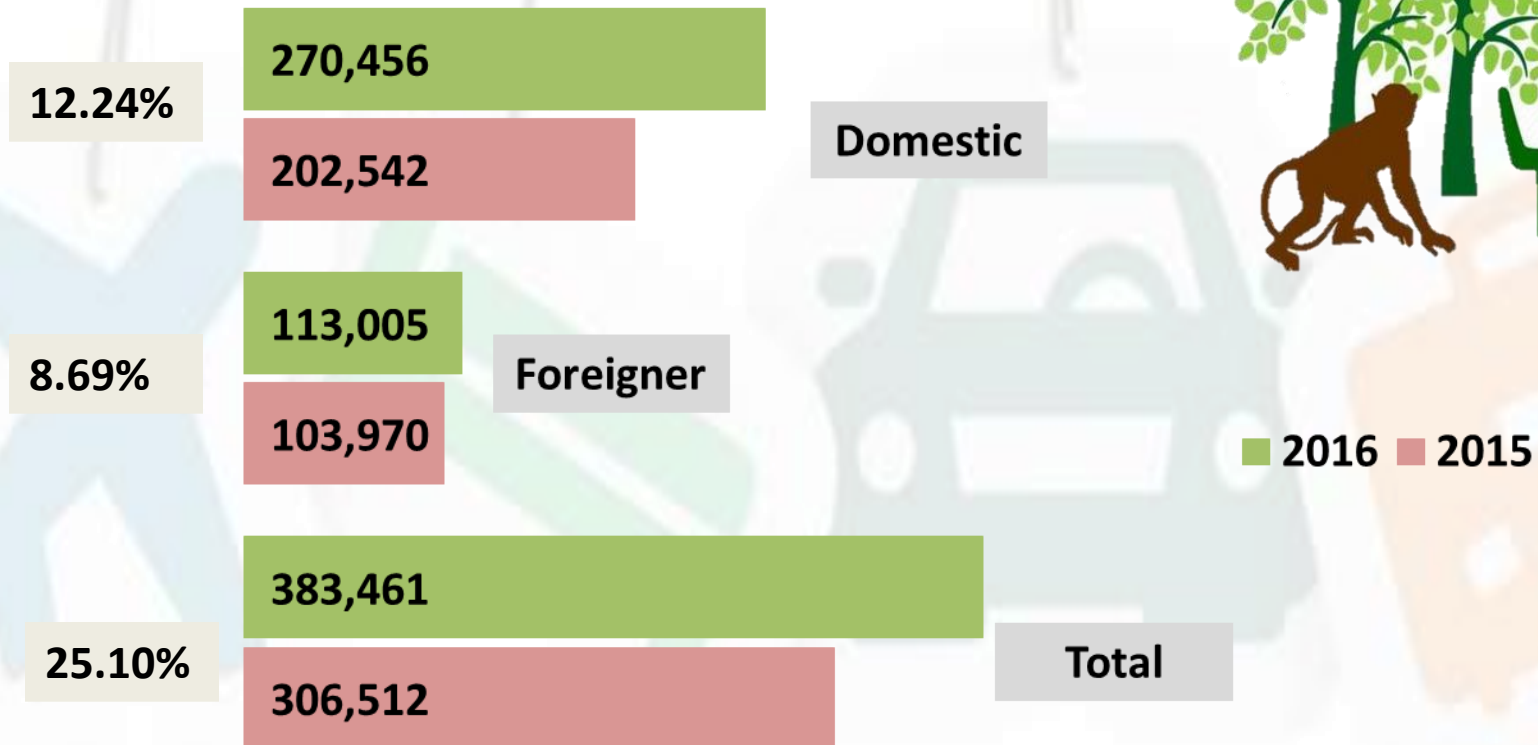

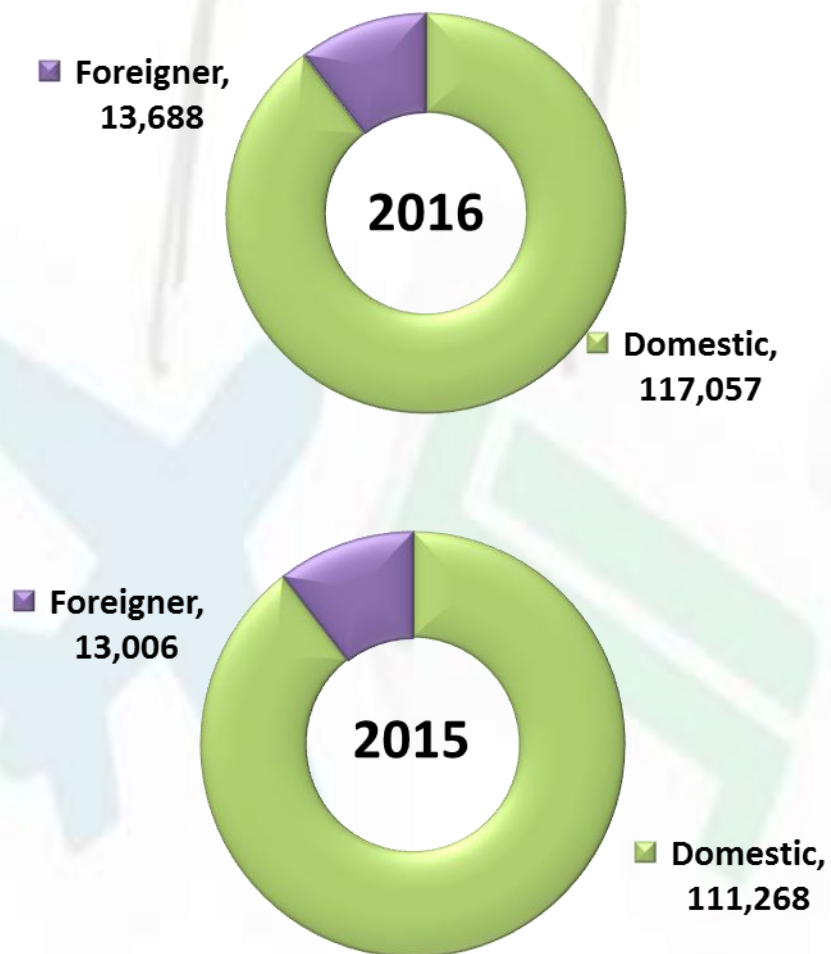

Visitor Arrivals To Sarawak Cultural Village, 2016

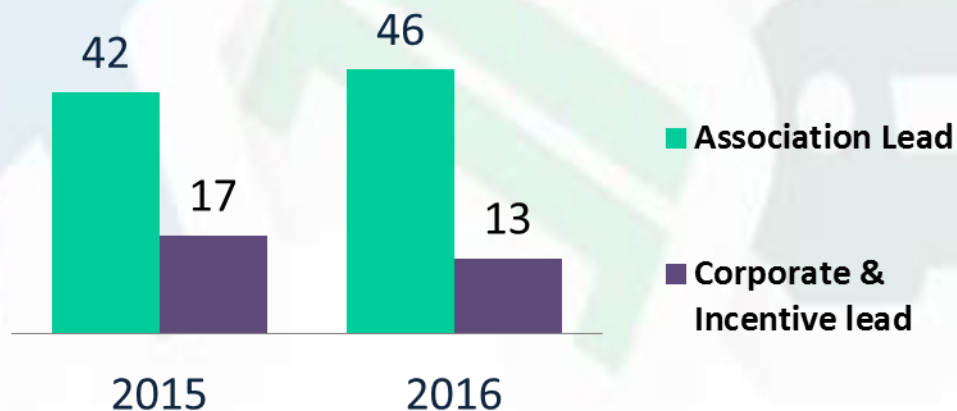

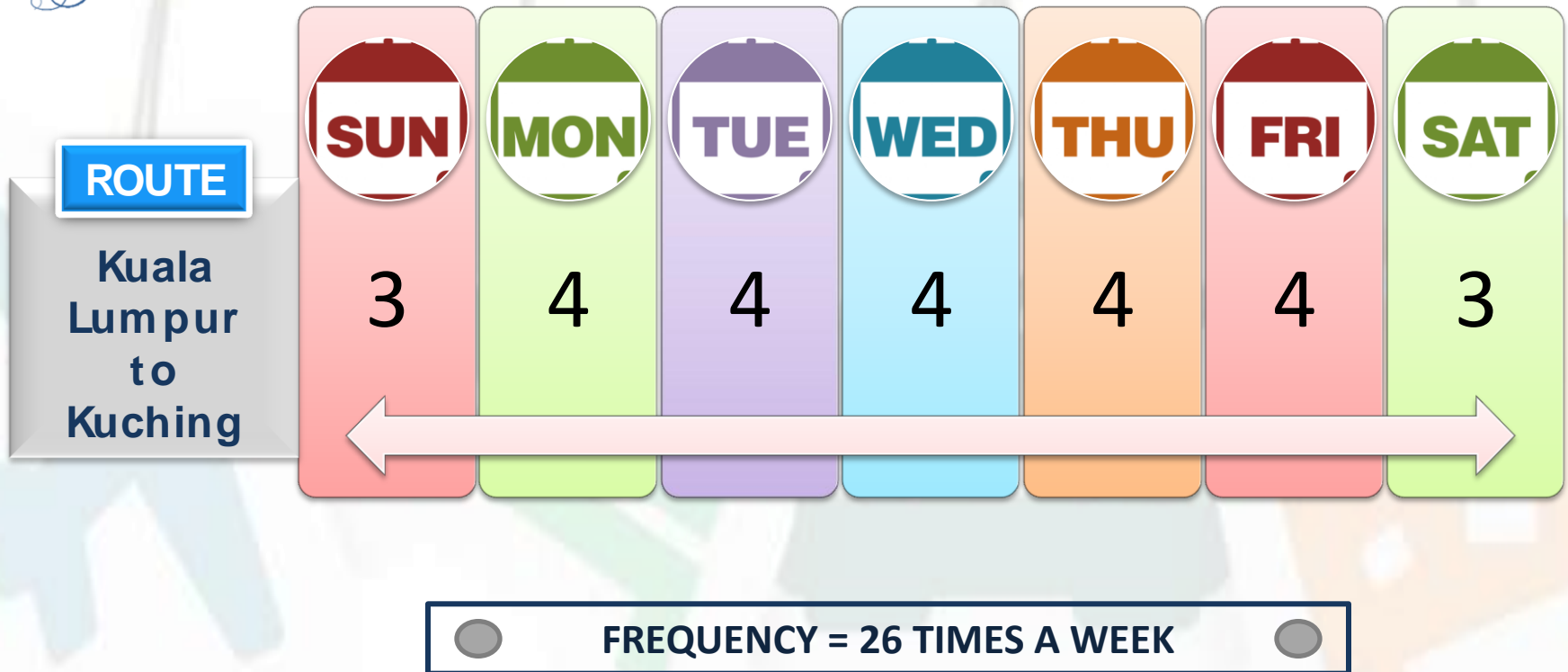
