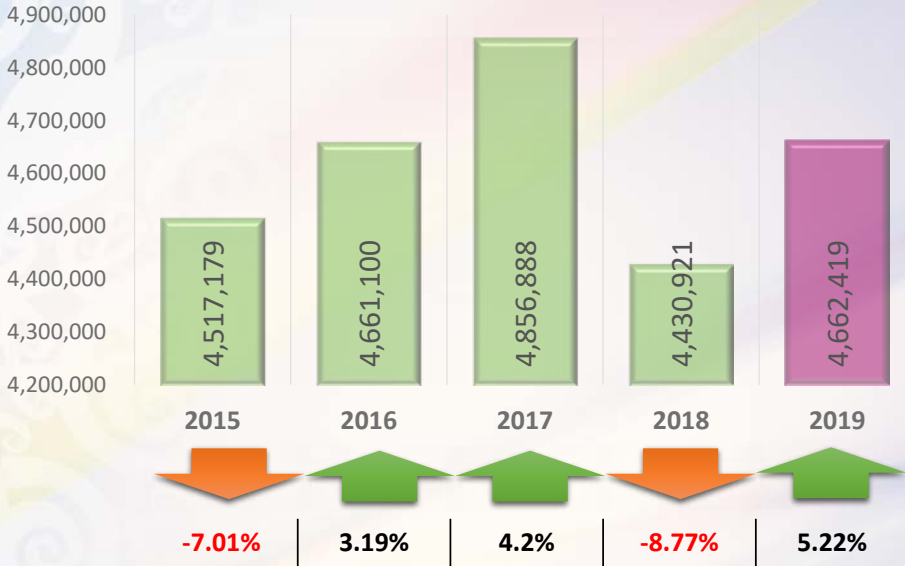

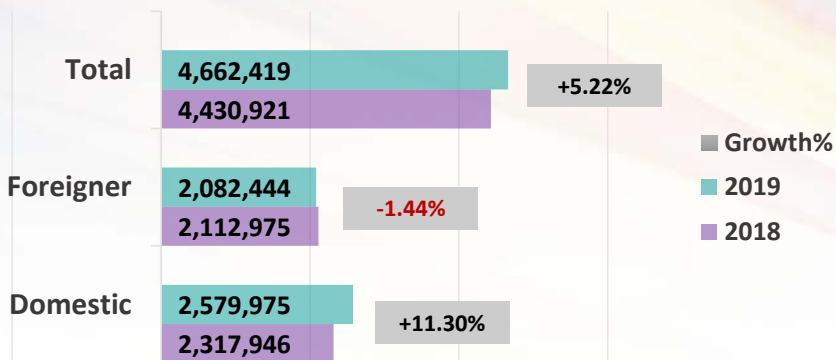

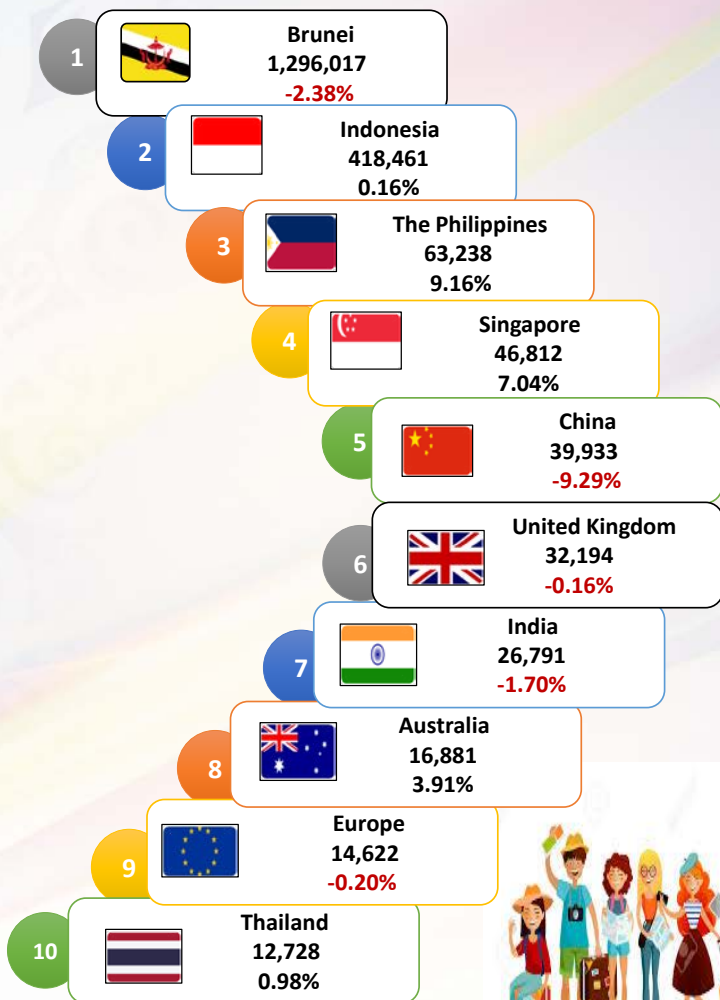

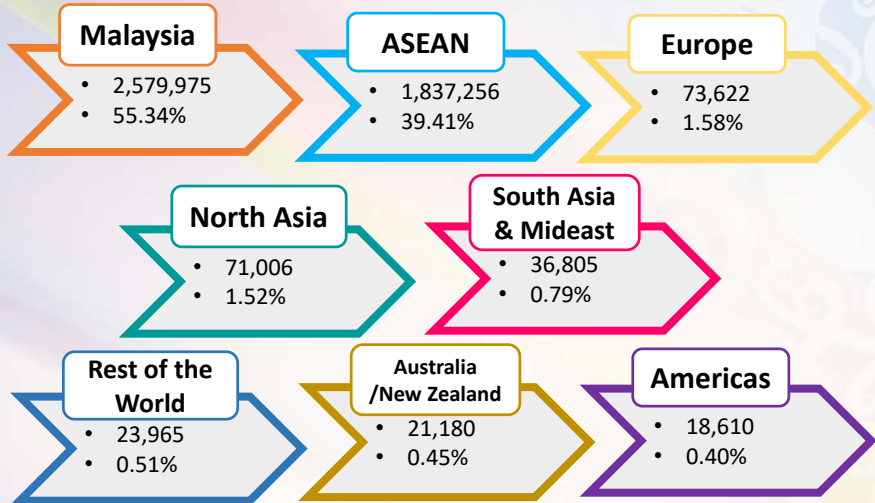


TOP 10 COUNTRY VISITOR ARRIVALS 2019

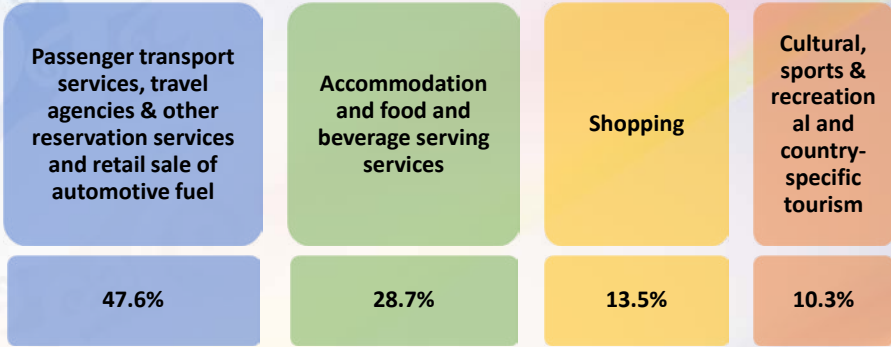

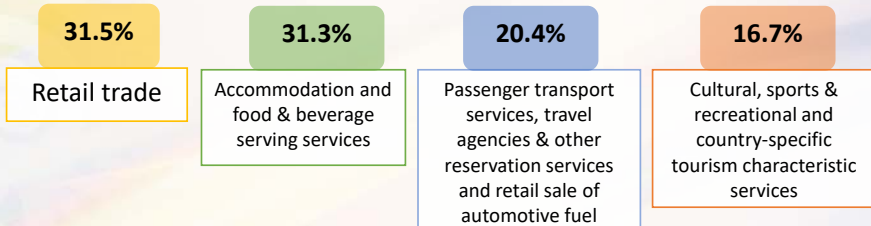

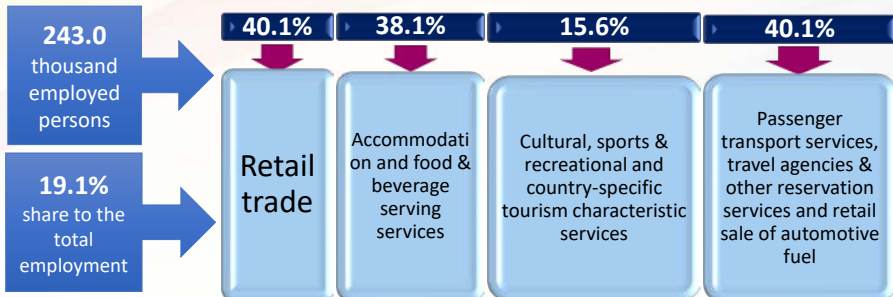
VISITORS SPENDING BY TYPES



PERCENTAGE SHARE (%) OF TOURISM INDUSTRY

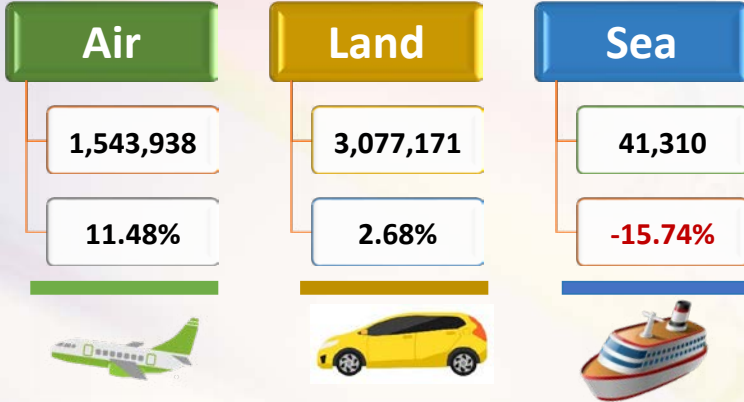


EMPLOYMENT IN TOURISM INDUSTRY

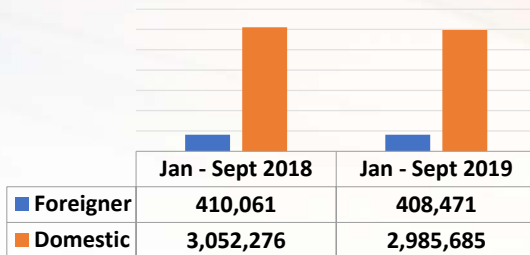
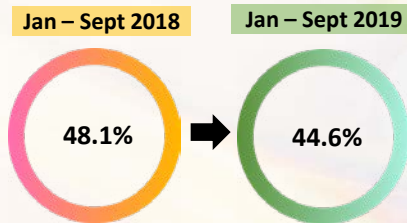

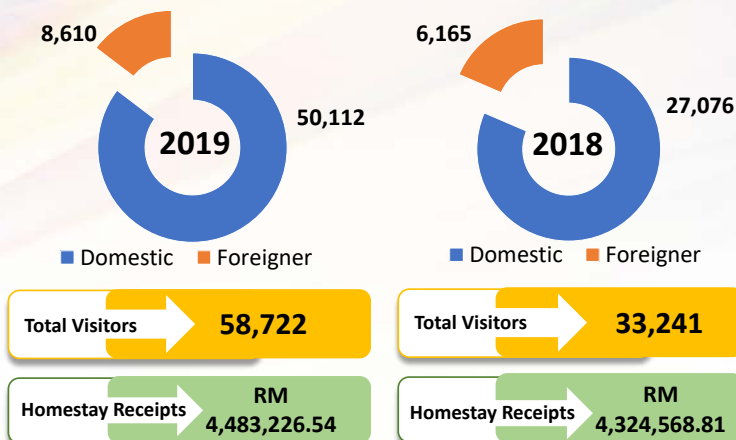

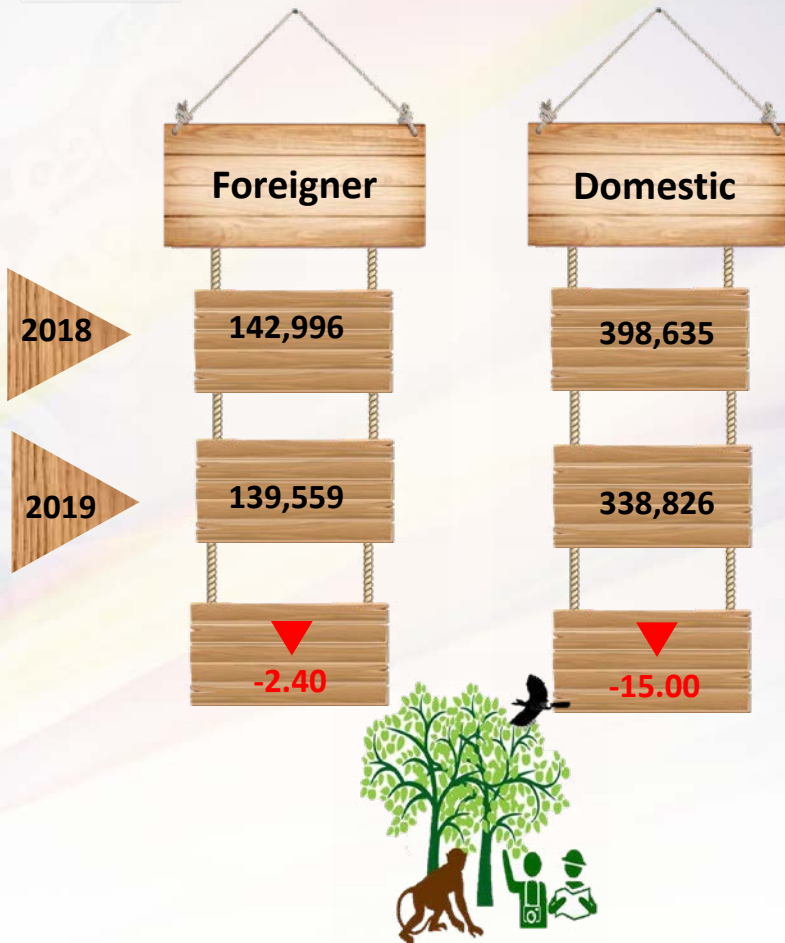

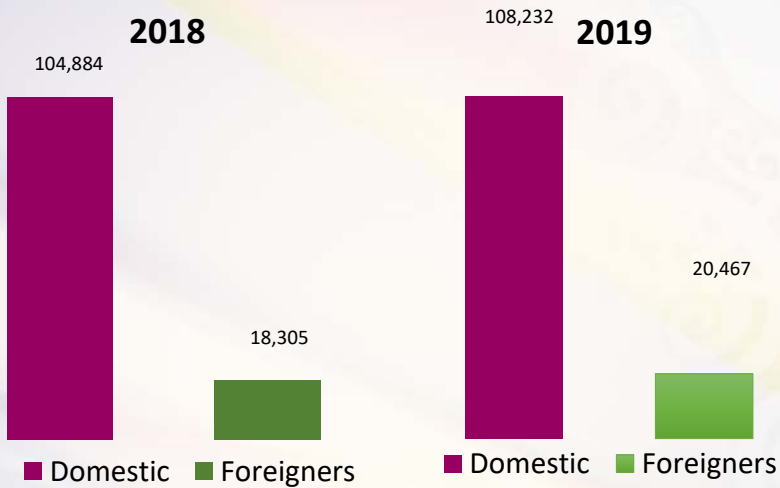

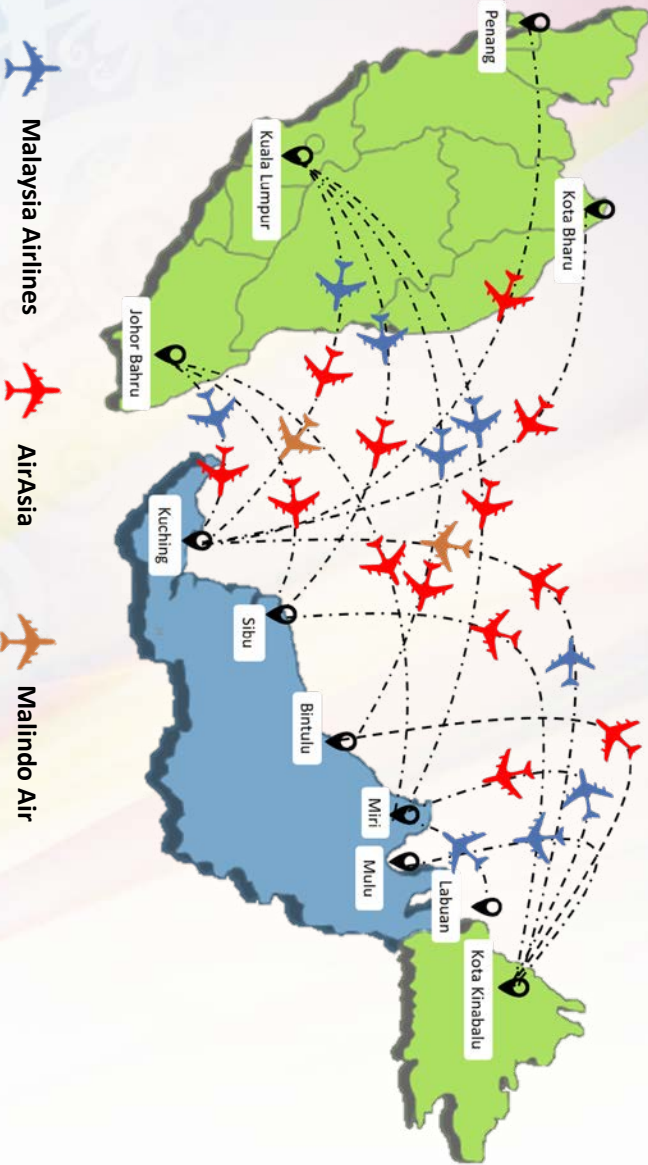
