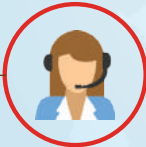

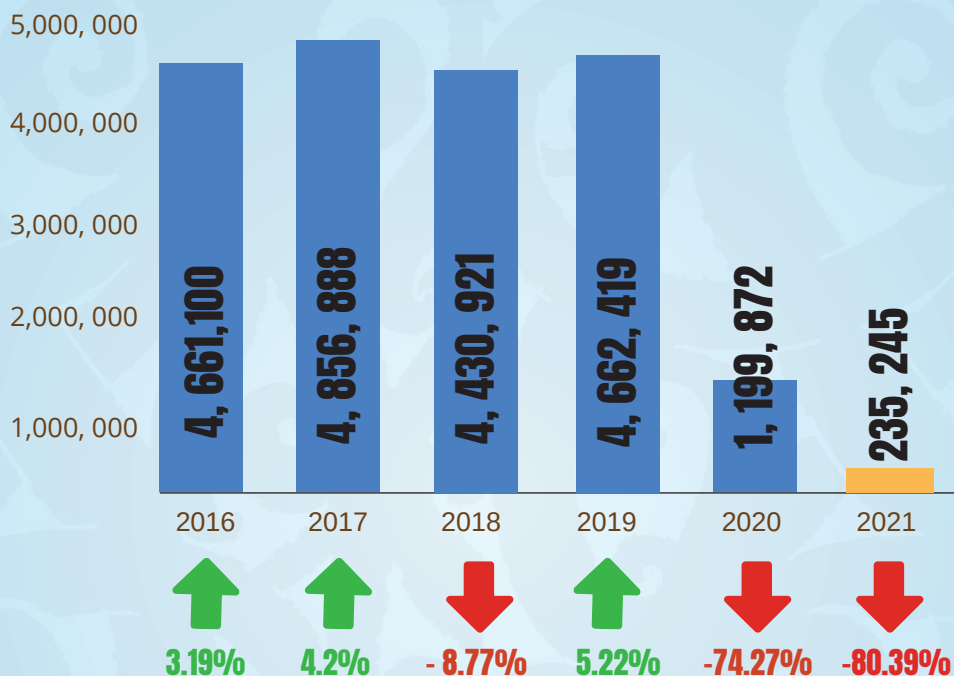

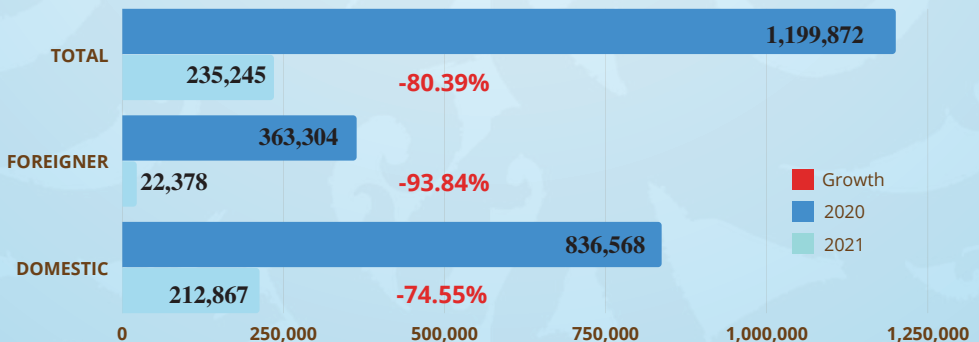

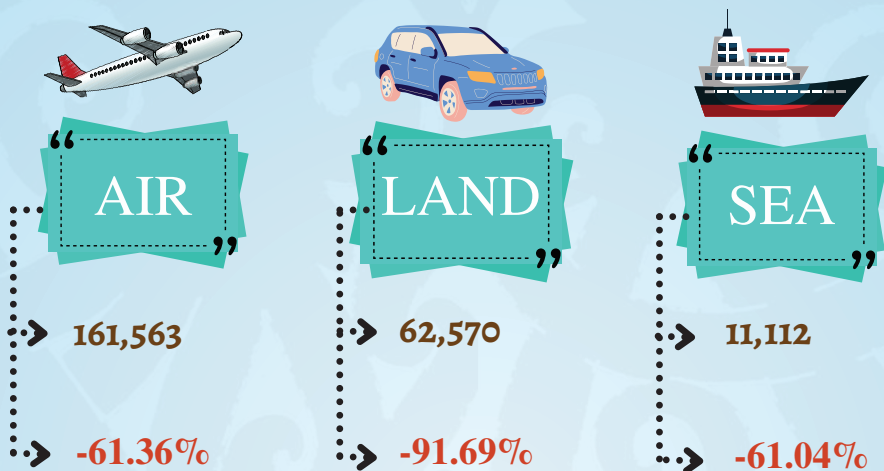
DOMESTIC AND FOREIGN VISITOR ARRIVALS TO SARAWAK 2021

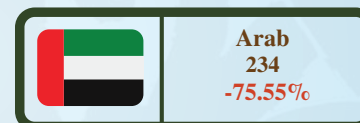
ENTRY POINTS BY SEA INTO SARAWAK



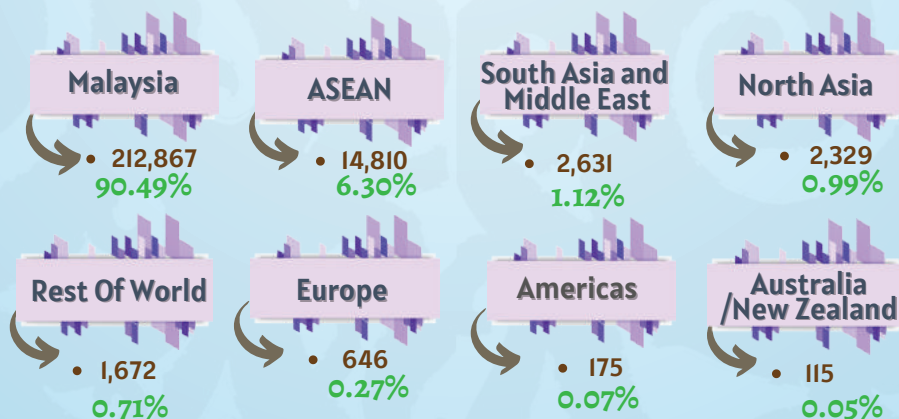

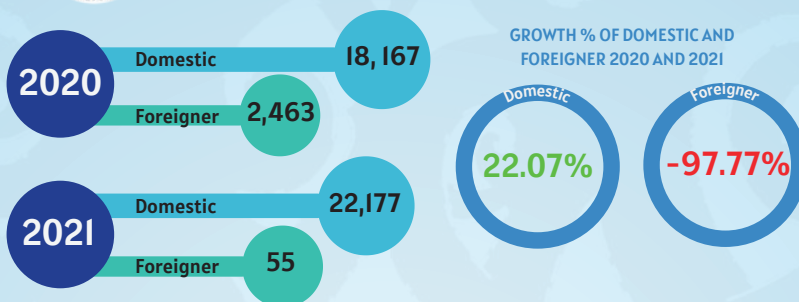

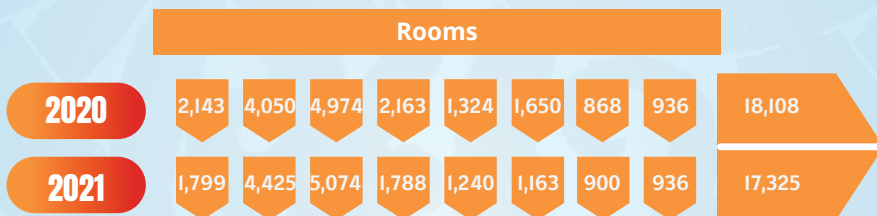

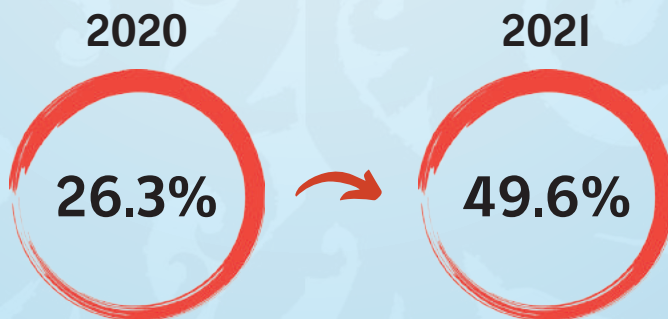

NUMBERS OF REGISTERED HOTELS BY CLASSIFICATION 2020 vs 2021



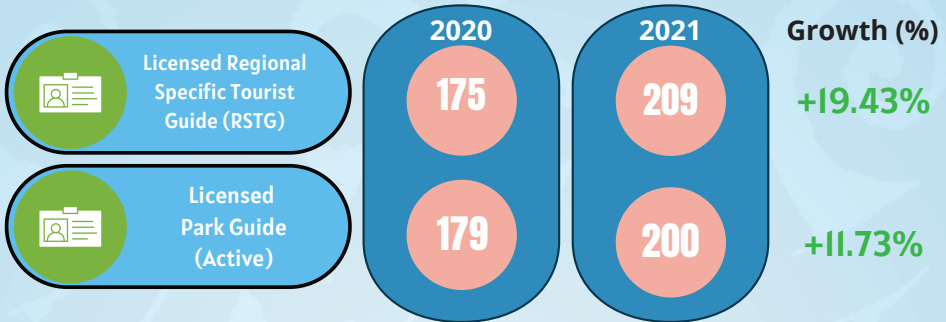
AVERAGE OCCUPANCY OF HOTELS IN SARAWAK 2020 vs 2021

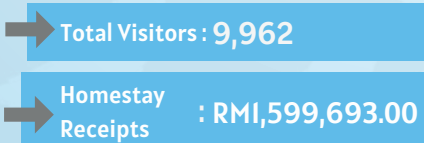

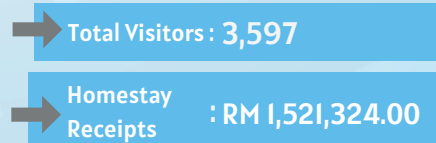

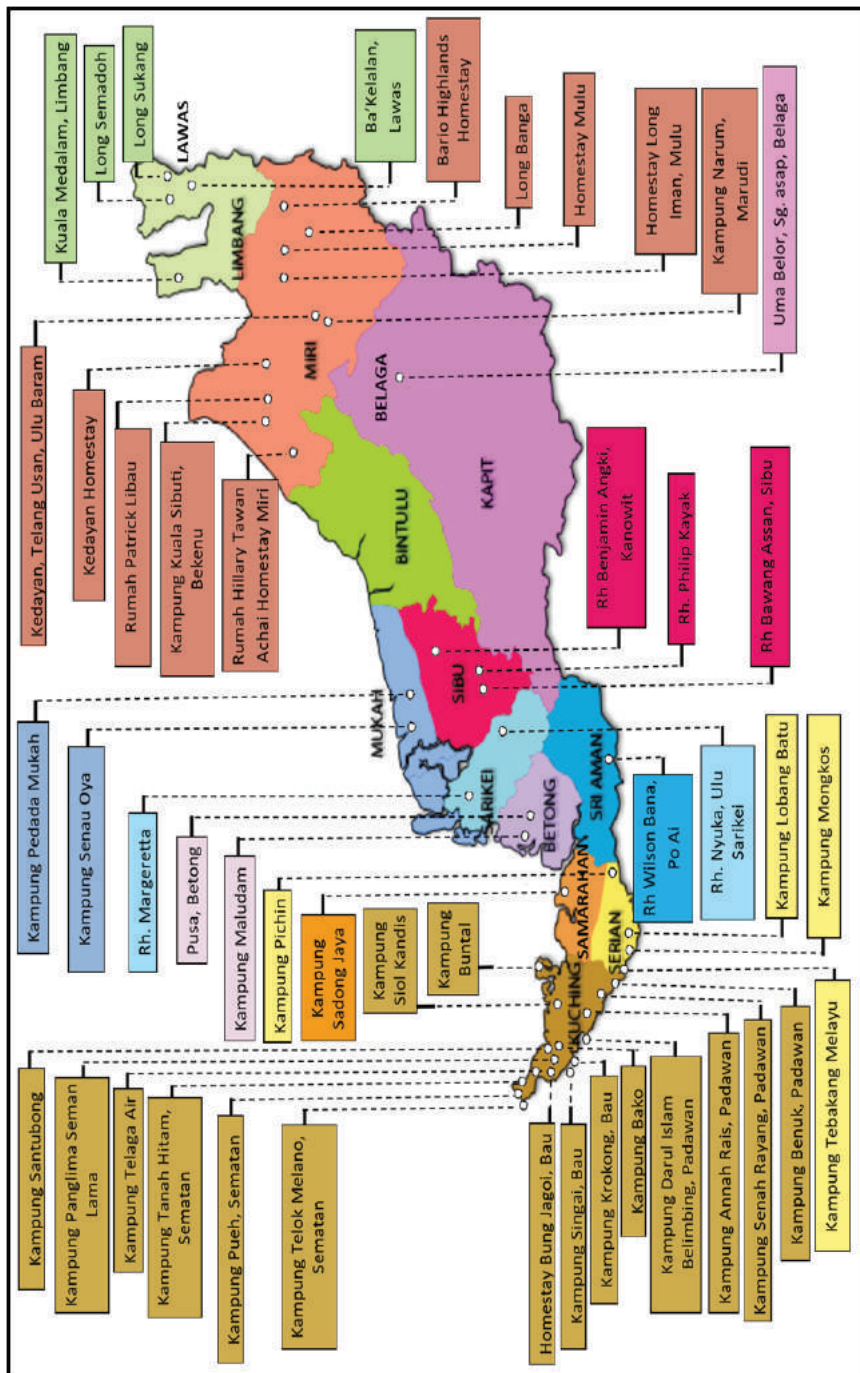

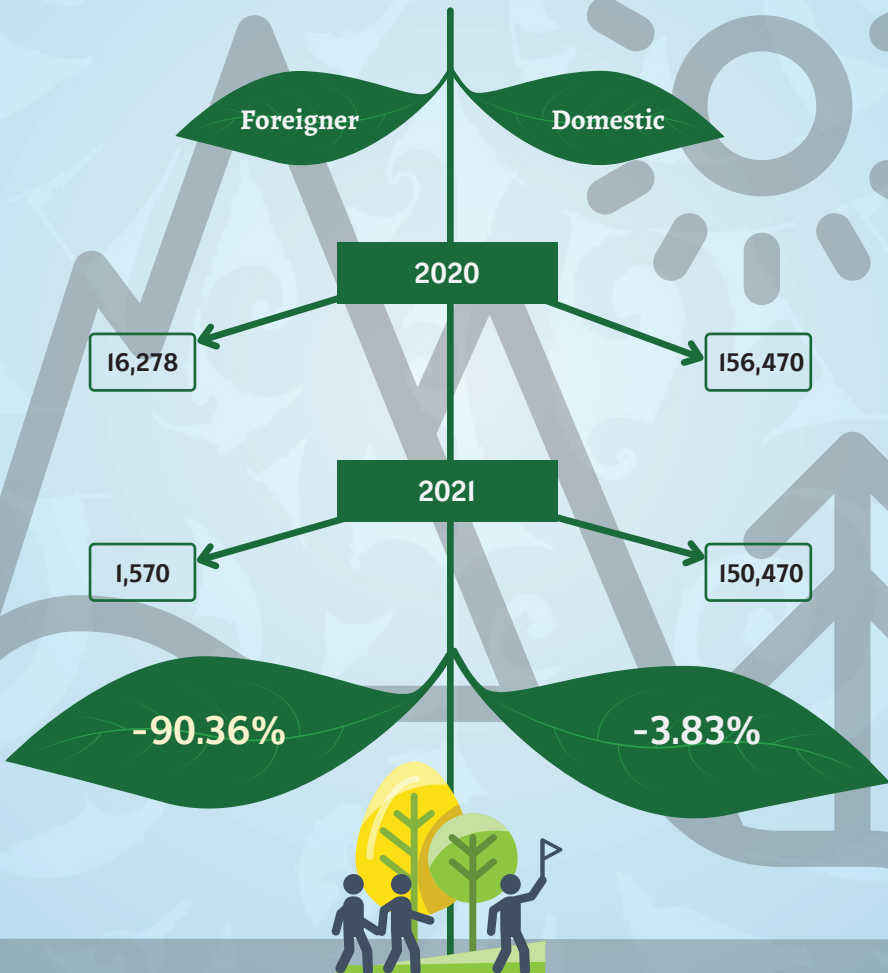

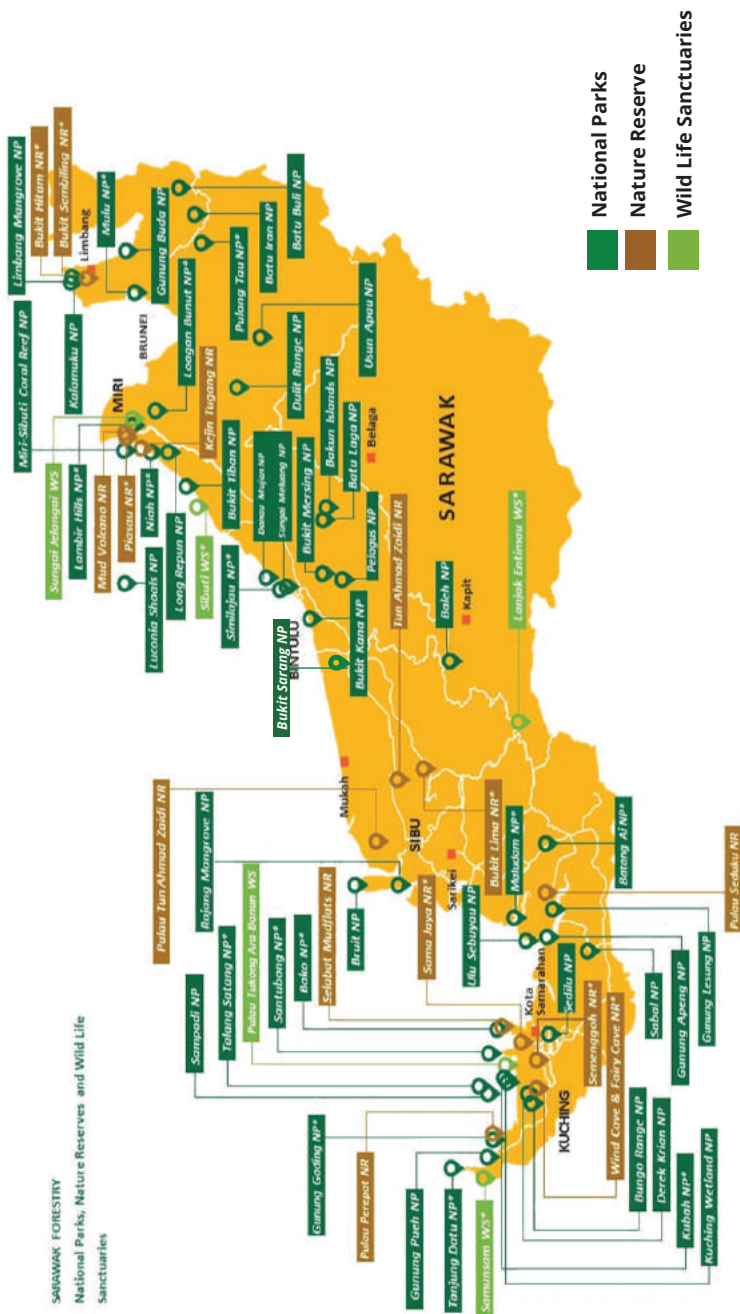
